Peter, former Director; Dr. Selvamani, Associate Director (Finance), Dr. Vinu Moses, Deputy Director (Gifts and Grants), Dr. Punitha Ezhilarasu, Mrs. Bharathy Jacob, Dr. Mary Sulakshini Immanuel, Dr. Chellarani Vijayakumar and Mrs. Rosaline Jayakaran, former Deans of College of Nursing; Mrs. Alice Augustine, former Nursing Superintendent; Dr. Vathsala Sadan, Dean, College of Nursing, as well as faculty and students of the College of Nursing. CME on "Living well with Parkinson Disease - an Allied Health perspective"



The Departments of Geriatrics and Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation conducted their 10th annual CME titled "Living well with Parkinson Disease – an Allied Health perspective" which was held on Wednesday, 11th January, 2023. Sixty-four Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy staff and students from various colleges and hospitals in and around Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh attended this CME.

The programme started with a word of prayer by Dr. Benny Paul Wilson, Associate Professor following which Dr. Gopinath KG, Professor and Head of Geriatrics welcomed the gathering. Dr. Thomas Samuel Ram, Associate Director, Missions emphasized the importance of the management of Parkinson Disease in older persons followed by the guest of honour. The felicitation addresses were given by Dr. Jacob George, Professor and Head of Department of PMR, Mr. Andrew Babu, Head of Physiotherapy Unit and Mr. Sanjeev Padankatti, Head of Occupational Therapy Unit, PMR.

CME on "Living well with Parkinson Disease-an Allied Health Perspective"

Dr. Gopinath K.G. spoke about Pathogenesis, types, stages, symptoms and clinical features of Parkinson Disease following which Dr. Benny Paul Wilson spoke about the treatment both pharmacological and non-pharmacological, side effects and treatment of complications. Ms. Merlyn gave a lecture on Physiotherapy interventions at different stages of Parkinson Disease. This was followed by the Red flags in initiation of exercise protocol and career education by Ms. Linda Blessy. Dr. V. Surekha and Ms. Dehita spoke about the Nutritional assessment, feeding and normal deglutition respectively. The last part of the morning session was the Question and Answer session led by Dr. Gopinath K.G., Dr. V. Surekha, Ms. Merlyn, Mr. Lenny Vasanthan, Ms. Linda Blessy and Mr. Earnest it was thoroughly enjoyed by the participants.

In the afternoon, participants attended three different skill stations for practical demonstration of swallow, speech and nutrition, fall risk evaluation, gait and balance and prescription of appropriate adaptive devices, held by Dr. V. Surekha, Ms. Teresa, Ms. Dehita, Ms. Merlyn, Ms. Linda Blessy and Mr. Earnest.

The CME was well appreciated by all the participants and faculty. We look forward to conduct more CMEs to train the therapists in the management of older adult, in order to "add life to years". Rev. Manibhusan Das delivered the message and concluded the CME with prayer.

State Level Workshop on 'Nurses' Role in the Management of Chronic Respiratory Illness in Children'

The Department of Paediatric Nursing, and CNE & Research, College of Nursing conducted a state level workshop on 'Nurses' Role in the Management of Chronic Respiratory Illness in Children' on 11th January, 2023. The programme started with prayer and inauguration. A total of 50 delegates attended the workshop. The aim of the workshop was to enable the nurses to understand chronic respiratory illness in children, describe the specific interventions for chronic respiratory illness and discuss the nursing care of children with chronic respiratory illness.

Faculty from the Department of Child Health and Paediatric Nursing shared the knowledge on overview of respiratory disorders in children, Asthma and Bronchiectasis including Cystic Fibrosis in Children, Respiratory Assessment in Children, Emergency Management of Children with Asthma, and Nursing Care of Children with Bronchiectasis including Cystic Fibrosis. In the afternoon, delegates were divided into 5 groups for hands on skill sessions on Airway Clearance Techniques for Bronchiectasis; Metered Dose Inhaler (MDI) Therapy and Newer Drugs in Asthma; Diet for Children with Chronic Lung Diseases and Cystic Fibrosis; Oxygen Therapy in Children and Assessment of Respiratory Status. The participants expressed that both the theory and hands-on sessions were very useful and will help them to confidently care for children with Chronic Respiratory Illness. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded eight credit points for the workshop.

Applications are invited from candidates interested in applying for Institutional Recommendation* for broad specialty medical postgraduate courses. The application for institutional recommendation will be via an online form. The link for this application and the departments offering sponsorship will be made available shortly, on the intranet page or by request from Principal's office (PG section) (princi.pg@cmcvellore.ac.in). Please note the following:

- Candidates interested in being recommended for courses must contact the respective heads of department mentioned in the list below to discuss the same.
- Candidates who ask for recommendation from a department other than the broad specialty department, must also meet with the head of the broad specialty department.
- A candidate may apply for recommendation for sponsorship for a maximum of 3 courses.
- Candidates who fulfil the following criteria may apply:
- CMC graduates who have fulfilled their service obligation. Non-minority candidates will be eligible to apply under the Institutional Preference Category.
- Christian candidates from other institutions who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital of which at least 6 months should have been in CMC. Christian candidates from other institutions applying for recommendation from a super specialty department and who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital or in CMC, should have spent at least 6 months in the concerned super specialty department.
- o Last date for completion of 2 years' service: 30th June 2023 (proof of completion of service must be provided with the application).
- The CMC application form for PG courses must be filled separately from the application for institutional recommendation/sponsorship (https://admissions.cmcvellore.ac.in/).
- Once the online sponsorship application form is filled and supporting documents uploaded, candidates will receive a copy of the submitted form via email. A printout of this form must be submitted to the concerned recommending departments.
- Please note that candidates being recommended for a broad specialty course by a different Department, will need to submit a copy of the application to both the sponsoring Department and the concerned parent Broad Specialty Department for approval of the sponsorship.
