

College of Nursing, CMC Vellore is now NAAC Accredited with "A" Grade

Being accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), the College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Vellore has secured "A" grade in the first cycle for its academic excellence in Nursing Education. NAAC so far has accredited 24 stand-alone Nursing Colleges; among them, we are the first to be accredited with the highest score for "A" grade in the country.

College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Vellore has stood tall for over 110 years now; obtaining this accreditation has made our alma mater see yet another mile stone. The Assessment and Accreditation process entailed meeting 7 Criteria with 33 Key Indicators and 109 Metrics, covering eight Aspects namely, Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, innovation and extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student support and Progression, Governance, Leadership and Management, Institutional Values and Best Practices and finally Nursing Quality Indicators. Apart from an online evaluation of our self-study report, three assessors visited our college on the 08th and 09th February, 2023 for physical verification of the infrastructure and documents in alignment with the seven criteria. On 9th February 2023 during the exit meeting the chairperson of the assessors spoke high about our functioning and highlighted on our sincerity and integrity. This accreditation is effective from 14th, February 2023 until 13th, February 2028.

World Encephalitis Day Celebrations

The Department of Infectious Diseases and the Department of Neurology, commemorated the World Encephalitis Day (WED) on 22nd, February, 2023 at CMC Vellore and CMC Vellore, Ranipet Campus. World Encephalitis Day is celebrated on February 22nd every year and marks the day when global awareness is generated worldwide for those affected by this disease. One person every minute is affected by encephalitis around the world and is a condition which is often preventable and some causes can be treated if recognized early thus lowering the risk of severe neurological disability and death.

This multi-department effort was inaugurated by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director, CMC who recognized the strength of CMC in delivering multidisciplinary care to those affected by Encephalitis.

Dr. Joy Mammen Associate Director Medical, inaugurated the programme at Ranipet Campus. Faculty from Infectious Diseases and Neurology offered felicitations and invited patients affected by Encephalitis or those who wanted information regarding Encephalitis to avail of the free screening organized by CMC with the help of Infectious Diseases, Neurology, PMR, ENT, Ophthalmology, Virology and Microbiology. 80 patients benefited in the free consultation camp organized on that day. Essay Competition, Poster Presentation and Quiz were conducted and cash prizes were given to the winners.

Various community awareness programme on Encephalitis were conducted at Sampath Nagar, Vellore on 23rd February and at DKM College on 24th February, 2023. We are grateful to the post gradate students from the department of Infectious Diseases and Neurology who gave awareness talks on Encephalitis to the community. Around 150 college students and community members actively participated and benefited through this program. Dr. Murthy Chamarthi visit to CMC



Dr. Murthy Chamarthi, a renowned interventional radiologist from the Vascular Institute of Texas, United States visited CMC Vellore on 25th January 2023. A multidisciplinary guest lecture on the management of peripheral arterial disease was delivered by him.

A workshop was conducted to treat patients with chronic knee joint pain endovascular approach. Mr. "R", a middle-aged gentleman was suffering from long-standing knee pain due to osteoarthritis. He was treated by blocking the geniculate artery supplying the chronically inflamed regions of the joint. He responded well to the treatment with a significant reduction in the pre-procedural pain score of 8 to 1 out of 10.

Knee joints are weight-bearing. Osteoarthritis of the knee joints is a common cause of disability worldwide. The treatment is by multimodality approach including medical and surgical. Geniculate artery embolisation, a day-care procedure is useful in a selected subset of patients.





1st Emergency Sonology Workshop

The Department of Emergency Medicine has conducted its 1st emergency sonology workshop on the 9th and 10th of January 2023 as a new initiative. The course covered topics relevant to point of care sonology which are useful in acute emergencies. Protocol based sonological assessment (Rush protocol, Blue protocol, Cause protocol) in acute illness and even arrest situations were discussed. Pain control has become a crucial part of the initial management in the emergency department. The workshop covered upper limb, lower limb and truncal blocks that are being used for pain control. This course has been designed to provide hands-on experience in emergency sonology.





State Level Workshop on 'Constructing Multiple Choice Questions'

The Department of CNE & Research, College of Nursing conducted a state level workshop on 'Constructing Multiple Choice Questions' on 14th February, 2023. The programme started with prayer and inauguration. A total of 38 delegates from different College of Nursing attended the workshop. The aim of the workshop was to enhance the faculty expertise in constructing MCQ's.

Faculty from College of Nursing, CMC, Vellore shared the knowledge on trends in testing, basic principles of testing, principles of developing MCQ, types of MCQs, validity and reliability of tests, and item analysis. After the sessions the delegates were divided into 6 groups for group activity to prepare and present on different types of Multiple Choice Questions according to their specialization. The participants gave a positive feedback on the usefulness of the workshop. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 7 credit points for the workshop.



CME on Recognition of Cardiac Arrest and Emergency Resuscitation

The Departments of Emergency Medicine and Continuing Medical Education organized a CME on Recognition of Cardiac Arrest and Emergency Resuscitation on 18th February, 2023.

The programme began with a talk by Dr. Priya. She first discussed the recognition of cardiac arrest and the management of cardiac arrests inside and outside the hospital. She then summarized the underlying causes of cardiac arrest and the emergency measures to manage these. Dr. Sivanandan discussed the types of bradyarrhythmias and an algorithm of management. Dr. Gina Chandy then spoke on cardioversion and medications for the different forms of tachyarrhythmias. Dr. KPP Abhilash discussed different approaches to management in special conditions such as pregnancy, hypothermia, drowning, obesity, pulmonary embolism, and trauma. Dr. Pradeep Daniel discussed guidelines for post-resuscitation care — critical to optimizing long-term outcomes. Dr. Mathew Verghese explained the evidence and techniques for targeted temperature management post-resuscitation care.

The highlights of this course were few didactive lectures with variuous group activities on the role of skills and simulation training in NMC competency based medical education, methods of teaching procedural skills, checklist preparation and integration of AETCOM in skills training and integrating technology in training. The course started with the prayer song by the PICU team. Rev. Dr. Aruldhas, Head of Chaplaincy conducted the inaugural prayerand Dr. Ebor Jacob welcomed the gathering. The other facilitators who are expereienced educators in simulation based training were Dr. Dinker Pai, Professor of Surgery and Director, Medical SimulationCentre, Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute (MGMCRI), Puducherry, Dr. Mahalakshmi, Dean - Health Profession Education, Professor of Pediatric Surgery, Arupadai Veedu Medical College, Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation, Puducherry, Dr. Hemanth Kumar, Professor and Head, Anesthesiology, MGMCRI, Puducherry, Dr. Archana. S, Asst. Professor, Department of Anesthesiology, Chief Coordinator, Skill and simulation center, JSS Medical College, Mysore, Dr. Geethanjali Ramachandra Co-founder PediSTARS & Pediatric Intensivist, KIMS, Hyderabad and Dr. Ebor Jacob, professor, PICU, CMC Vellore and President, PediSTARS. There were 55 participants who were faculty of diverse specialities from various medical colleges and the feedback given by them was encouraging. The Tamil Nadu Medical Council accredited this activity and awarded 2 credit hours.

Sponsorship for Staff Children - Admissions 2023 - 2024

Please include the following matter in the next issue of the C.M.C. Weekly News:

Applications are invited from staff for sponsorship of their children for admission to the various training courses in the Christian Medical College, Vellore for the Academic Year 2023 - 2024. Online sponsorship forms will be available in the Intranet page à Staff Self Service à Sponsorship Portal from 3rd March 2023 onwards. Retired Staff can kindly contact Directorate for applying online sponsorship form.

A. Eligibility: (Cl.Min.No.5188-11-79; 7449:6:93 & 9282:1-2003)

- 1. Only children of confirmed C.M.C staff members who:
- (a) have put in 10 years of continuous service including period of probation and are currently in service in any capacity in the Institution as on 30th June of the year under consideration; (OR)
- (b) have retired after at least 15 years of continuous service in the Institution, or have taken voluntary retirement after 25 y ears of continuous service; (OR)
- (c) have been discharged from service on medical grounds after at least 15 years of continuous service; (OR)
- (d) have died during service after at least 10 years of continuous service in this Institution are eligible to apply for sponsorship.
- 2. Legally adopted children of staff members whose adoption was finalized at least five years before the date of application are also eligible for sponsorship, subject to the above criteria.
- 3. Regarding a confirmed staff member who died during service to the institution and whose spouse has been given a job in CMC in place of the deceased staff member, dependent children of the deceased staff member will be eligible for CMC sponsorship if the cumulative years of service of the deceased staff member and his/her spouse (including probation and confirmed periods) exceeds 10 years; in case the child applying for sponsorship was legally adopted by the deceased staff member, the adoption of the child should have been finalised:
- (a) prior to the death of the deceased staff member, and
- (b) at least five years before the date of application for sponsorship

B. Conditions for sponsorship of staff children (Cl. Min.5759:3-84)

- (a) Only one child from a family can be admitted in a year to any single course.
- (b) Children from the same family can, however, be admitted to different course in the same year.
- (c) Sponsorship is allowed from only one sponsoring body, so children applying for C.M.C. sponsorship cannot also be sponsored by one of the supporting Churches of the Council.
- (d) Where there is more than one sponsorship obtained, the one received first which satisfies the criteria will be accepted.
- (e) No withdrawal of first received valid sponsorship is allowed.

Staff children, even with CMC sponsorship, must still meet the minimum academic qualifications for the courses for which they are applying. Staff are urged to check the prospectus to ensure the eligibility of their children for the various courses before submitting their applications.

Important deadlines:

4.30 pm of 04/04/2023: Last date for submitting sponsorship application forms (hard copy) to the Director, Christian Medical College, Vellore.

Last date for submission of copy of self-attested mark sheet of qualifying examination to be announced. Please watch the CMC Intranet Home page for details. (Please note as per Tamil Nadu Government Orders – for MBBS admission First and single attempt marks only will be considered).
