Dr. Bala Seetharaman, Nursing Superintendent and Professor in Medical Surgical Nursing superannuated on 15th March 2023 after 39 years of dedicated service in the institution. She is a prominent alumnus of College of Nursing, Christian Medical College Vellore. She started with Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery in 1981 and pursued her education to complete Post Basic BSc in Nursing in 1991, Masters in Nursing in 1999 and Doctorate of Philosophy in Nursing in the year 2016. She also completed her Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Law and Ethics offered by National Law School of India University, Bangalore in 2020. She has been an ardent worker throughout her career in various capacities. She began to work as a Staff Nurse in Medical Ward on completion of Diploma Nursing in 1984 and later moved to Maternity Nursing Department. She also assumed the role of Charge Nurse/Tutor in Medical ward after completing PBBSc Nursing and also worked as a Tutor in Fundamentals of Nursing Department. She made an immense contribution to the field of Cardiology Nursing after her Master's specialization in Medical Surgical Nursing. She has headed the Department of Medical Surgical Nursing Specialty I comprising of ENT Ward, Nephrology, Endocrinology & Cardiology Ward,

Respiratory Ward, Urology Ward, Plastic Surgery and Burns Unit, Day Care Unit for Medical Patients, Bronchoscopy & Pulmonary Function Test Unit and Multi-unit Medical Ward. She has taught several nursing subjects to the students of various nursing programs and has contributed richly towards the clinical supervision of students posted in her assigned clinical areas. She has held several administrative responsibilities in both academic and clinical arena.

She has served as an Additional Deputy Dean for four years taking care of Post Basic Diploma Nursing Programmes, Deputy Nursing Superintendent for a period of three years and Nursing Superintendent since 20th October, 2020 till 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2023. She has taken efforts to ensure high quality nursing care being rendered to patients, encourage research activities by nurses and implement research findings to improve patient care and student education. She has been a life member of Trained Nurses Association of India (TNAI) and Christian Medical Association of India (CMAI). She has been a resource person for several workshops and conferences and served as an examiner for the university and board examinations and has a lot of publications to her credit in various national and international journals. Her husband Mr. Seetharaman has a business in Vellore, daughter Mrs. Shivanthi and son-in-law Mr. Manoj work as a Software Engineers in Chennai and son Dr. Sreevathsan is an MBBS alumnus of Christian Medical College, awaiting to do his post-graduation. ## World Kidney Day 2023

The World Kidney Day was celebrated by the Paediatric Nephrology subdivision on 9th March, 2023. The theme for this Year was – **Preparing for the unexpected, supporting the vulnerable**.

This day, celebrated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of March every year was inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Dr. Benny Paul Wilson, Deputy Medical Superintendent of CMC. Rev. Dr. T. Arul Dhas, Chaplain lead the programme in prayer following which Dr Joy Mammen, Associate Director, Dr. Kala Ebenezer, Professor and Head, Paediatric Department, Ms. Mabel, Additional Deputy Nursing Superintendent and Dr. Deepthi R.V, Associate Professor Paediatric Nephrology addressed the gathering. Prizes for the various competitions held during the week were awarded by the Chief Guest.

The World kidney day activities began a week prior with several competitions being conducted. These included essay writing, poster drawing, logo and slogan competition - all of which drew a very enthusiastic response from nursing staff and students. This year, a written quiz competition was held for nursing and medical undergraduate and postgraduate students. The participation was tremendous with all participants demonstrating good knowledge of kidney disease. Certificates and prize money were awarded to the first three in each category during the inauguration ceremony.

Interactive sessions with parents were held in the wards with educational posters made by students adorning the walls generating questions on kidney problems. Many queries were responded to by the pediatric team of doctors and nurses. In the paediatric wards and the outpatient department, health education was given to parents and children.

The main highlight of the day was a free health check-up for children with screening for kidney disease. Stalls staffed by dialysis therapists and nephrology nurses were set up to demonstrate peritoneal dialysis and haemodialysis with machines and mannequins. The stall set up by the dietary department assisted by our unit dietician demonstrated ideal diet and portions for children with different types of kidney diseases and was noted to be the most popular stall. The dieticians educated the parents of children with chronic kidney disease on different techniques to enhance the child's appetite and to meet the nutritional requirement.

There was a special **Organ Donation drive** to register healthy volunteers for donating their organs after death. A total of 21 healthy volunteers pledged their various organs for donation, the youngest being twenty one years. World kidney day themed T-shirts were on sale and was very popular among both patients and staffs. The World kidney day celebrations ended on a very optimistic note.

The Paediatric Nephrology specialty has been conducting World kidney day celebrations for the past fifteen years. This activity has helped to increase awareness about kidney disease in the local community, both amongst children and their parents. Realising the importance of early screening, eating healthy diet, regular exercise and focus on personal health is a small beginning towards improving kidney health.
