Dr. Rita Caroline Isaac retired as a senior Professor of Community Medicine from RUHSA department on 24th March, 2023 after 47 years of association with CMC Vellore.

Her first contact with CMC was when she came to this institution as a first year medical student and took admission on 1st July 1976 leaving her home in Wayanad for the first time. She completed her MBBS in 1982 and went onto do her bond in CSI Mission Hospital Codacal, after which she shifted to Tirupur where she worked in a charity trust clinic till 1994. She re-joined CMC in 1994 as junior clinical assistant and continued till 1996 when she joined as PG registrar in the Department of Community Medicine. She joined RUHSA in 1999 after her post-graduation and continued to provide service till her retirement. She did her MPH from Tufts University, Boston in 2004-2005 and was appointed as the Adjunct Associate Professor at Tufts University in 2006 and continues till date. She became the head of the RUHSA Department in October 2009 and continued till her superannuation in March 2018. She held the post of Deputy Director, CMC (Publicity and Promotions) from 2015 to 2018.

She provided visibility and credibility to RUHSA over the years that she worked there and initiated many activities for the welfare of the Department. She was immediately put in charge of beautifying the campus – a responsibility she took very seriously. She trained local women’s groups in waste management and gardening – the efforts of which are seen in the pristine campus that RUHSA has today. On taking charge of the clinical side of the department, she ensured that the patients in RUHSA had access to the best possible care that anyone could get at a secondary level. Her emphasis on evidence based medicine and adaptation to low resource settings ensured that RUHSA had protocols for all levels of management. She also made sure that the facilities in RUHSA were improved constantly. This resulted in a renovated inpatient block, new OPD building, canteen for patients as well as new machines for labs. She also engaged with a number of other Departments in CMC such as ophthalmology, psychiatry, neonatology and dental to expand the scope of comprehensive primary care given at RUHSA. Other infrastructure projects in RUHSA under her guidance included a renovated chapel, renovated hostel for trainees as well as new guest house – NOOAH house.

She also initiated community development projects for the people of the K.V. Kuppam block. Some notable ones include - Youth development project started with an aim to meaningfully engage the youth of K.V.Kuppam, Stall-Fed Goat farming- a new initiative for making elderly centres sustainable, One candle project supports education of student’s from most poor families of the villages of K.V. Kuppam Block and Integrated Farmers development project to uplift marginal farmers and promote organic farming. Two projects that were close to her heart was the elderly centres - which provide one nutritious meal a day along with physical and psychological support to poorest of the poor elderly who do not have any other source of support and Community college - which she continued to nurture - for the local youth (10th or 12th pass or failed) who were provided vocational training and life skills education and placements and improve their social-economic status and value in the society. Dr. Rita always believed that the health of a community has to be approached through tackling the social and economic determinants side by side with improving medical services.

She had an eye for research related to problems of the local community of the K.V. Kuppam block with specialisation in implementation research. She got NIH grant for research on HIV-AIDS patients. She collaborated with Weil Cornell Medical College, University of Sydney, University of Edinburgh and Prevent Cancer foundation, USA for starting and continuing her research on cervical cancer screening, education, diagnosis and treatment, which was then the commonest cause of death among women from cancers. She collaborated with University of Aberdeen to start screening, diagnosis and treatment of Diabetes patients from our area using health care workers under patient navigation system. Similarly what started as a research project for CRDs in collaboration with University of Edinburgh and funding from NIHR RESPIRE, Govt. of UK had become a service with a weekly respiratory wellness clinic for CRD patients. She has more than 50 publications in national and international journals.

All her research was deeply rooted for the welfare and wellbeing of the community and has helped in improving the quality of medical care at RUHSA through training, new equipment and use of evidence-based protocols among the RUHSA practitioners.

She was supported throughout by her daughter Dr. Judith Aaron [MBBS batch of 2002], currently working as a consultant radiation oncologist in Caritas Cancer Institute, Kottayam, her son-in-law Mr. Rijo Abraham, Scientist in DRDO, Cochin and blessed with the three beautiful grandchildren Ryan, Richard and Rebecca.

She has dedicated her life to the service of the people with 24 years of continuous service at RUHSA. She was an able administrator with a keen eye for detail and focus on efficiency. The pages allotted for expressing our gratitude are not enough to list in detail the amount of work she has done for this institution. She is intensely spiritual and has firm belief in God’s work and purpose – it is with this strength that she started work at RUHSA and continued to do so till her retirement. She has been a mentor, colleague and a friend over the years but above all she is a beautiful person at heart. She had led her life in her own terms without compromising the principles of the institution and brought recognition and glory to CMC Vellore. We wish her best of luck and pray to God for her health and happiness and continued pursuits in making health for the most vulnerable in India a reality.

First Microvascular Penile Replantation Surgery Done at CMC Vellore

A thirty-year-old male suffering from delirium following alcohol withdrawal presented in the casualty at the CMC Ranipet campus with a self-inflicted injury using a sickle knife resulting in complete amputation of the penis. He presented 2 hours after the injury. He was hypotensive and was shifted to the operating room after resuscitation by the Emergency Department. He underwent a 9-hour surgical procedure to reimplant the amputated penis. The microvascular repair of the arteries, vein and nerve was done by the Plastic surgery team led by Dr. Jonathan Victor. The urethral and corporal repair was done by the Urology team under Dr. Sukdhev and Dr. Deepak David Chellapa. Post operatively mental health care was provided by the Psychiatry team. The replantation was successful and the patient was discharged after 2 weeks. Penile amputation is a rare clinical entity with only a few reported cases of successful replantation. Timely referral and timely surgical intervention are the keys to success.

The programme started with prayer and inauguration. Total 46 delegates attended the workshop. The aim of the workshop was to enable nurses to update their knowledge on benign and malignant breast disorders, learn multi-modality approaches to breast cancer and to provide highest level of holistic nursing care.

The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 8 credit points for the workshop.
