Mr. T. Nandakumar, Manager and Acting Head of Internal Audit retired on 28th April, 2023, after 27 years of dedicated and committed service to the Institution in two phases viz., from 1986 to 1996 and from 2006 to 2023. In between, he has worked as a Chief Accountant in a reputed hospital in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and in Worth Trust as a Finance Manager.

Mr. Nandakumar completed his undergraduate studies at Voorhees College, Vellore, and his postgraduate studies in Commerce at Madras University. He is a Cost and Management Accountant (CMA) and a Fellow Member of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of India, Kolkata, and a Member of the Institute of Internal Auditors, India as well. Diploma in Hospital Administration (DHA)

The Department of Hospital Management Studies & Staff Training and Development (DHMSSTD), Christian Medical College, Vellore in collaboration with the Christian Medical Association of India (CMAI), New Delhi started the Diploma in Hospital Administration (Distance Education Programme) course from 2019. This course was designed mainly for those working in the mission Hospitals willing to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to become efficient managers and leaders while continuing to serve their institutions. It will help them to integrate theoretical and scientific frameworks with their own experience in order to implement best practices in their hospitals which would provide them the ability to deal with a range of management issues.

The fourth batch of participants had their mandatory contact programme from 27th February to 11th March, 2023. The contact classes started with prayer and welcome address by Dr. Samuel N.J. David, Sr. Manager & Head, DHMSSTD & Chairperson, CMAI Administrators section. During the contact programme, the day started with prayer followed by detailed classes on 8 subjects (Basic principles of management, Basic accounting and finance, Materials Management, Managing Patient Care and Hospital Facilities, Hospital information systems, Human resources management, Hospital governance and statutory requirements, Quality and Safety in Healthcare) lead by various intramural and extramural faculty. The participants visited various departments and gained practical administrative knowledge on its functioning. During the course of the programme, the participants were addressed by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director, CMC Vellore who spoke of the challenges of managing a mission hospital and encouraged the participants to take active interest in becoming better administrators and managers for sustainability of the mission hospital network. Dr. Vijay Anand, Missions Consultant, CMC Vellore and Former Director, Makunda Christian Hospital spoke about his experience in sustainably managing the hospital in a remote rural setting. Dr. Anbu Suresh, Medical Superintendent, Scudder Memorial Hospital Ranipet, spoke about his experiences in managing the hospital and the challenges faced in sustaining the hospital through the years. Dr. Abel Asirvatham, Quality Consultant, covered aspects of quality pertinent to a mission hospital towards providing safe and appropriate care for patients and staff. Dr. T.S. Ravikumar, retired Professor, Department of Emergency Medicine, took an interactive session on Disaster Management.

The contact programme was attended by 24 participants which includes medical doctors, nurses and administrators representing nearly 11 mission hospitals across the country. During the programme, the participants were taught the theoretical and practical aspects of Hospital and Health Systems Management through interactions, department visits, presentations, group discussion, etc. The programme was well appreciated by all the participants. Their feedback of the contact programme was very positive, based on their responses detailing the usefulness of the sessions and department visits from a practical point of view, the well developed and robust systems of our institution, the new aspects learned by them and the arrangements for the programme including faculty and venue.

Obituaries

• **Dr. Adolf Walter** (MBBS batch of 1951) passed away on 27th April, 2023. Dr. Adolf Walter, MBBS Batch of 1951, passed away on 27 April 2023 at the age of 89. He is survived by his wife Dr. Sylvia (MBBS Batch of 1950), retired Professor and former Head of the Physiology Department, CMC Vellore, as well as his daughter Leela, and two sons - Noel (MBBS Batch of 1975) and David (MBBS Batch of 1977). Dr. Walter spent his childhood years in South Kanara before joining CMC as a medical student in 1951. After completing his MBBS he initially worked as a medical officer in the Murugalli tea estate in the Western Ghats before returning to CMC to do his postgraduation in Pathology, which he completed in 1965. After that, he joined the faculty of the Pathology Department and worked there for many years, eventually becoming Professor. Early in this period



(during the late sixties) he got the opportunity to work, for about 2 years, in Llandough Hospital in South Wales, where he studied pneumoconiosis with Chris Wagner, a pioneer in this field and particularly in asbestos-related lung cancers. This training helped make pulmonary pathology one of Dr. Walter's areas of special expertise. He also worked in Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Adelaide (in 1974) and, in the early eighties, in Rashid Hospital, Dubai. In 1987 he helped establish Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology as a diagnostic service in CMC Vellore.

Obituaries

Dr. Walter was strict and had a tough exterior. He saw the world in black and white and was uncompromising on his principles. Yet he was also known for his sense of fairness and many who trained under him also spoke of his kindness towards them when they needed it most. In the department, he usually preferred to keep to himself, but also enjoyed the company of Dr. Doss Sudarsanam, his best friend, and Dr. Anand Date. His career in pathology notwithstanding, Dr. Walter was a polymath with a wide range of interests and abilities. He was a skilled carpenter and made a lot of his own furniture, often as good as or better than the local professionals of the day. His drawing, painting, carving and musical skills were exceptional - a reflection of his artistic bent. He played the piano and violin brilliantly and was largely responsible for his children developing their own musical talents. He was fond of athletics and ran barefoot for much of his life. Even after retirement he continued to run, often comparing his own progress with that of other state and national level veterans. A do-it-yourself man, in his later years he even took up bookbinding and bound many books and magazines himself. A private person and devoted family man, he always actively supported his wife and children in all their activities. Although he did not suffer from significant ill health for much of his life, in his later years he developed arthritis and cognitive impairment that eventually took their toll.
