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Dr. Nylla Shanthly, Physician, Department of Nuclear Medicine, superannuated on 22nd April 2023, was born and raised in Neyveli. She joined CMC Vellore as a young MBBS student in the year 1974. After completing her bond and working for a few years in Kerala, she re-joined in the Department of Nuclear Medicine in the year 1994. Recognising the Institutional need, she took up the challenge of undergoing the DRM training at the Radiation Medicine Centre in Mumbai and joined back in the Institution.

Along with Dr. Regi Oommen and an able team of Physicists and Technologists, various milestones and landmarks in both diagnostic and therapeutic services were witnessed. From the early 1990s, CMC became a model of Nuclear Medicine-based healthcare in the country.

She was a skilled teacher and contributed immensely to the training and wholesome development of students for decades. Her guidance and creativity was indispensable to the various Research Studies carried out in the department. She was loved by all her patients who were touched by her genuine love for them. Inpatient Electronic Medical Records (IP EMR) Services in P2 ward

CMC Vellore reached another significant milestone on the 2nd of May 2023, with the inauguration of the Inpatient electronic medical records (IP EMR) services in P2 ward. The IP EMR system is a fully online electronic chart based within the clinical workstation that replaces the traditional handwritten metal charts that have been used for several decades at CMC. The deployment of the IP EMR systems at CMC brings us closer to the vision of a fully paperless hospital system.

The system was formally launched with Surgery Unit-I at P2 ward being the first surgical unit to begin using IP EMR services, following a successful trial run in O5 East under Geriatrics over the past few months.



The service was inaugurated by Dr. Rajesh I, Medical Superintendent, in the presence of Dr. Joy Mammen, Associate Director, Dr. Prasad Mathews, the former Medical Superintendent, Dr. Benny Paul, Deputy Medical Superintendent, Mrs. Alice Sony, nursing superintendent, Mrs. Sophia Vijayananthan, Additional Deputy Nursing Superintendent, Dr. Pranay Gaikwad, and the Surgery Unit-I team and Ms. Anisha Macaden and the CHIPS team. The laptops and IP EMR services were prayed over and dedicated by Rev. Saramma from Chaplaincy.

With the initiation of the IP EMR network, doctors and nurses can now access the entire IP chart from anywhere in the CMC hospital network instantly. The system provides instant access to real-time patient data from anywhere in the hospital-from vitals signs, intake/output values, and ongoing medications, to being able to create and edit medications and treatment orders, to being able to view and generate clinical notes and records.

The fully digitized IP chart provides a permanent record and solves the problem of illegible handwritten notes and promotes better documentation and efficiency by seamlessly integrating medical information from across the entire breadth of clinical services in the CMC network.

Access is restricted only to those with workstation privileges for that patient, thus helping the institution to be ready for compliance with upcoming Indian privacy regulatory requirements. The IP EMR services will also reduce healthcare costs by eliminating the need for paper chart storage, record keeping and maintenance expenses.

The speakers from different wings of the administration spoke about the years of work and collaboration across multiple teams that was needed to bring this project to fruition. A recurring theme was the importance of ensuring that the human touch was always maintained, irrespective of how advanced our systems may become. As the service rolls out to more and more wards, the benefits of this system will be felt by patients, health care workers and the institution, in the continuing quest to uphold the legacy of excellence in patient care that began with Dr. Ida Scudder.



Event for children with ASD organised by CAP & Nambikkai Nilayam

In accordance with this year's theme for World Autism Month – 'Transforming the narrative', the team in the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry & Nambikkai Nilayam unit organised a fun-filled program for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and their families on the 27th of April 2023, in collaboration with student volunteers from the medical, nursing and allied health fields.

Children once diagnosed with ASD, are often excluded from other children, and access to schooling becomes challenging. Social inclusion is key to progress. To improve social awareness and inclusion, the month of April is celebrated as 'World Autism Month' and the 2nd of April as 'World Autism Awareness Day'.

About 35 children along with their family members participated in the recently held event for Autism Month. Activities like ball-sorting games, bouncy castle, face painting and musical chairs were conducted. A 'Community Tree' was made with handprints of the children, parents, staff and students.

Student volunteers were assigned to each child to guide them with the process and with interactions. The students also conducted action songs for the children and events for the parents. A highlight of the evening was a special song by Mr. Samuel Ashish Marcus titled *Accept me as I am* and inspiring messages from Mr. Marcus' mother and another parent of a child with ASD.

The unit would like to specially thank the Principal, Dr Solomon Satishkumar, for his whole-hearted support for this initiative and all the students for their enthusiastic participation. The event was graced by Chief Guest, Dr. Vinod Abraham, Vice Principal of the College and other members of the CMC community.

ASD is a neurodevelopmental disorder, characterized by qualitative impairment in social interaction, communication and repetitive and stereotypic patterns of interests and activities. The condition has significant impact throughout the life of the individual and is now considered as a priority mental health condition that needs to be addressed early in life. The World Health Organisation in 2023 estimated that about 1 in 100 children worldwide have an autism spectrum disorder. An INCLEN study conducted across five States in India in 2021 found that the ASD prevalence was as high as 1 in 125 children between 2-6 years age group, and 1 in 80 among children between 6-9 years age, with an overall prevalence of 1 in 89. Early diagnosis and therapy greatly improve the trajectory of children with ASD.

We hope that this event would be a step towards improving awareness and acceptance among young health professionals, to further support and help in 'transforming the narrative' for children with ASD.



Drivers Training Programmer (DTP)

The Department of Hospital Management Studies and Staff Training and Development (DHMSSTD) conducts various training programmes pan institutionally. Owing to the shifting of a number of specialities to the Ranipet Campus recently, CMC initiated transportation services for users throughout the weekdays and weekends on a scheduled basis through the Transport Department. In view of the increased movement of users, CMC also uses outsourced providers on a contract or need basis. As these services may not necessarily provide the needed training for their personnel i.e., drivers, the training need for provision of uniform training for these drivers was identified by the department and accordingly, the Drivers Training Programme was conceptualized by the department. The purpose of the DTP is to provide training to outsourced drivers as well as our institution Drivers of Transport Department in various aspects of road safety, emergency handling and professional behaviour in order to provide safe transport services in a consistent manner. The content and dissemination models were developed by the department based on the job descriptions of the drivers as well as the institutional requirements. In order to ensure attendance by drivers and avoid programme clashing with their work schedules, the DTP was scheduled for Saturday afternoons.

The first DTP was conducted on the 28th January, 2023 followed by a second DTP on 4th February, 2023 both of these DTPs covered the entire employee driver strength (48 drivers) of our institution. A third DTP was held on 16th February for outsourced bus service drivers (16 drivers).

The proceedings of the first DTP held on 28th February, 2023 were as follows: The DTP began with the prayer by Rev. Benjamin, chaplain. Dr. Samuel N.J. David, Associate General Superintendent and Head, Department of Hospital Management Studies & Staff Training and Development gave the welcome address to the drivers emphasizing the importance of drivers in hospital. Mr. Durai Jasper, Deputy General Superintendent and Public Relations Officer covered a detailed session on CMC's history, vision & mission, patient's rights and responsibilities and grievance redressal cell. Mr. Anbarasan, Asst. Manager, Chittoor Campus gave a session on basic traffic rules and legal aspects, followed by a session on the role of drivers in a hospital setup and the commensurate skills required by Mr. Edin Decoster Lawrence, Asst. Manager, Transport. Mr. Thiagarajan Asst. manager, OPD, took a session on appropriate behaviour when dealing with patients, work ethics, hospitality culture, employee engagement and involvement. The Penultimate Session was covered by Ms. Krushna, Jr. Lecturer on personality development, awareness of infections, alcoholism, smoking, communicable diseases and their management, team work, integrity, effective communication and stewardship. The final session of the programme was taken by Ms. Anitha Edward, Management Asst. on HIC covering the aspects on hand hygiene and bio-medical waste disposal. At the end of the programme, feedback on the programme, content, delivery and other aspects were collected from the drivers. Overall, the feedback from the drivers was excellent.

DTP will continue to be conducted in future to cover the entire outsourced driver population towards optimal driver effectiveness.
