Celebrated annually on 5th May 2023, "World hand hygiene day" aims to stress the need for hand washing among the healthcare workers and visitors to prevent the transmission of infection and providing safe and effective care to the patients. The World Health Organisation (WHO) states that hand hygiene is the cornerstone for providing safe care to the patients. The theme for Hand Hygiene day 2023, "Accelerate action together", focuses on encouraging the health care workers at all levels to clean their hands at right moments using soap or alcohol based hand rubs and bring people together in this campaign to ensure safety and quality in patient care.

To commemorate this day, the Hospital Infection Control Committee of CMC Vellore organised an awareness program on 5th May, 2023. Dr. I. Rajesh, Medical Superintendent and Chairman of Hospital Infection Control Committee, inaugurated the week by cutting cake and congratulated the HIC team for commemorating this day. He stressed the need for strict adherence to hand hygiene by all healthcare workers to combat hospital acquired infections. Dr. Rajiv K Dy.
