Dr. Vathsala Sadan, Dean, College of Nursing superannuated on 10th June 2023 after 38 years and 11 months of dedicated service in the Institution. She had completed B.Sc Nursing in the year 1984 and specialized in Community Health Nursing with Master's Degree at College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Vellore. She obtained the Doctoral degree from the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai. She started her professional career as a Staff Nurse in Community Health Nursing Department and climbed up the ladder to become the Professor and Head of the Department. She served as the Head of the Department for a period of two years from 01/06/2021 to 10/06/2023. She worked with immense passion and contributed to the growth and development of the department. She is very talented in gaining the co-operation of the local community towards the expansion of services in the rural areas served by the department. She had innovative ideas in encouraging Community Participation. She has been very instrumental in the establishment of Kannigapuram Outreach Clinic and initiating Women Empowerment programme for the CONCH areas. She has been an excellent teacher in the field of public health, an approachable and friendly teacher to her students. She has been the SNA Junior and Senior Advisor and has always been a source of support and strength to the Student Nurses' Association.

As a dynamic leader Dr. Vathsala Sadan served the Board of Nursing Education, South India Branch of Christian Medical Association of India (CMAI) for eight years and has been instrumental in promoting

quality education for the Diploma Nursing Programme. She is currently the Vice president of CMAI. She also made an impact in the post graduate Nursing Education at Sultan Qaboos University, Muscat during her sabbatical leave. She has also contributed to the revision of BSc Nursing syllabus, being on Academic Review Committee member at the Indian Nursing Council. She has been a resource person for several academic events at various levels and has numerous scientific publications to her credit and has guided undergraduate and postgraduate student in their research work.

Her tenure in the Dean's Office had witnessed several achievements and brought laurels to College of Nursing amidst the challenges of COVID-19. The College was furnished with the State-of-the-art facility of an Advanced Simulation Centre for Excellence in Nursing funded through ASHA Grant in January 2023. The College was also accredited with "A" grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council in February 2023.

Dr. Vathsala Sadan's husband Mr. S. Sadan is a Retired Cashier from Canara Bank. The Luminary Lecture Series: Mr. Ramachandra Guha

Towards community building across the many campuses of CMC, the popular Luminary Lecture series, one of the highlights of the Centenary Year of Medical Education in 2018, was re-started. This series aims to feature luminaries from non-medical disciplines, with a focus on humanities, social and environmental issues etc., to educate, inspire and broaden the knowledge of the CMC community in its understanding of the world at large.

The first Lecture for 2023 was delivered by Mr. Ramachandra Guha on 21st June 2023 to a packed Scudder Auditorium. The program started with prayer by Rev. Joseph Devaraj, followed by the College Song. The Principal, Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar welcomed that gathering, that comprised members of the CMC community, retired staff, and students of local schools and colleges. The Director, Dr. Vikram Mathews, introduced Mr. Ramachandra Guha.

Mr. Ramachandra Guha, one of the best-known current historians in India, is also well known as a biographer, columnist and environmentalist. His Lecture was titled 'Lineages of Indian Environmentalism'. Mr. Guha mentioned the seminal Chipko andolan of 1973, which is often seen as the beginning of environmentalism in India. His talk focused on the prescient writings and work of five people from the early to mid-20th century. They raised the alarm that development sans ecological sustainability would only lead to environmental degradation and disaster for human populations in the long run. Mr. Guha spoke of the aesthetic, educational and political environmentalism of Rabindranath Tagore; the sustainable agro-forestry of Mirabehn (who worked with Gandhiji for many years);

the inter and trans-disciplinary ecological thinking and approach of Radhakamal Mukerjee (Professor of Economics at Lucknow University); the wholistic urban planning principles and aspects that Patrick Geddes, a Scottish town planner, espoused, and the broad and comprehensive focus on sustainable environments by Madhaviah Krishnan, a pioneering wildlife photographer, writer and naturalist.

Following Mr. Guha's enlightening, erudite and passionate talk, Dr. Deepa Ramaswamy, Professor of Psychiatry chaired a lively interactive session. Dr. Vinod Abraham, Vice Principal (UG), proposed the vote of thanks and the programme ended with the National Anthem.

The department is equipped with state-of-the-art technology, including a linear accelerator (True Beam), Tomotherapy, an Integrated Brachytherapy suite, a CT simulator, Exactrac, SGRT, Gating systems and Imaging lab. This has enabled us to offer high-quality care at an affordable cost including those who are socioeconomically disadvantaged.



In the past year at Ranipet campus, the department has rendered state-of-the art cancer services, including 4700 radiation treatments, 600 brachytherapy and 850 daycare chemotherapy treatments. The patients have expressed an overall good experience with the facilities and quality of care. We thank God for enabling to start the cancer rehabilitation programme in the OPD area at Ranipet Campus. Also, during the recently held NABH inspection, the inspectors mentioned the department as an Area of excellence. We praise God for this milestone in the journey of our department.
