The CME attracted more than 200 delegates representing more than 50 medical colleges from various parts of south India, and was also live telecasted to the mission hospitals. It was accredited with 10 CME points by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

The CME was inaugurated by Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, the Principal, Dr. Dincy Peter, Head of Dermatology and Dr. Mary Jacob, former Professor and Head of Dermatology. The programme concluded with a quiz competition which attracted postgraduates from 15 colleges and kept the audience intrigued.


International Day against Drug abuse and Illicit Trafficking

Safe Blood Transfusion Practice for Nurses



The Departments of Medical Surgical Specialty XI Nursing and CNE & Research, College of Nursing conducted a **state level workshop on 'Safe Blood Transfusion Practice for Nurses'** on 23rd June, 2023. The day began seeking God's presence with prayer. A total of 50 delegates from within and outside the institution attended the workshop. The objectives of the workshop were to enable delegates acquire in depth knowledge on blood components, storage, grouping, crossmatching, screening of donors, bloods afety protocols in hospitals, management of blood transfusion reactions, considerations in pediatric transfusions and also to update their skills on safe transfusion practices. The sessions were covered by the faculty from the Departments of Haematology, Transfusion Medicine, Medical Surgical Specialty Nursing XI. Nursing faculty from Scudder Memorial Hospital, Ranipet and Apollo Hospital, Chennai reflected on blood supply challenges in secondary level hospitals and evidence based guidelines for blood transfusion respectively. The content was delivered via diverse educational methods such as discussion, demonstration, video presentation and quiz. The day ended with an observational visit to the blood bank. There was active participation and learning. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 6 credit points for the workshop. We thank God Almighty for His enabling grace.


