After completing M.Sc. in Zoology from Scott Christian College, Nagercoil, he joined the Bachelor of Divinity course, at United Theological College, Bangalore. In 1989 he joined the institution as a chaplain. He received PG Dip. in Psychological Counselling, from Christian Counselling Centre, Vellore, and went on to do his Doctorate in New Testament at University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He has also received training on Bioethics from Manipal University.

He has served two times as the Head of Chaplaincy from 2006 – 2009 and 2018 – 2023. He also served as a core faculty member in the, Department of Bioethics, CMC Vellore.

Rev. Dr. Arul Dhas has been faithful to the call he received from Christ to be a compassionate chaplain to patients and their families, an excellent trainer, writer and scholar in the field of Pastoral Care and Hospital Chaplaincy. He guided many staff and students of this institution in retreats. He tirelessly worked for the growth of Chaplaincy and fulfillment of the vision of the institution. He strengthened the arm of the healing ministry of Church, taking it to the wider ecumenical circles. He shared the love of God to everyone who came in contact with him. He always advocated for the needs of the poor and the needy and leads a life of simplicity and grace.

He has published many articles in the field of Pastoral Care and Counselling, Healing Ministry of the Church, Biblical response to Poverty and Justice, Identity of a Christian Community, Spirituality and Suffering, Ministry of a Chaplain, Ethics in Healthcare, Healing Ministry and Pandemic, Pastoral care for the differently abled people, Human Dignity, .Death and Dying.

He has taught theological students at different seminaries in India and abroad and guided students in higher studies in Theology and Counselling. During his Sabbatical, he taught, at the Theological College of Lanka, Pilimatalawa, Sri Lanka.

He has been a resource person at various workshops and training programmes in the healing ministry of the Church. This includes providing Lay leaders training in Counselling to help victims of earthquake in Gujarat and victims of Tsunami and Flood. He has also been a resource person on 'Stress Management' for pastors and trainees in pastoral care.

He has coordinated a series of Grief Counseling Training Programme for the staff of CMC, Vellore and also coordinated the Clinical Pastoral Education units (12 weeks) programme in Christian Medical College, Vellore. Many of our staff and trainees in Pastoral Care and Counselling were benefited by his training.

# The National Surgical Nursing Conference

National Surgical Nursing Conference at CMC Vellore highlights role of surgical nurses in Shaperecovery after surgery.

Continuum of surgical nursing care is the way forward to impact patient outcome

The National Surgical Nursing Conference was organised by the Surgical Nursing Department of College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Vellore on the 25<sup>th</sup> of July 2023, focusing on the theme, **Continuum of Nursing Care in Gastrointestinal Surgeries - The Way Forward.** The objective of the conference was to update the nurses on fundamental shifts in the process of care after gastrointestinal surgeries. The keynote address on 'Evolution, History and Challenges of Surgical Nursing' was delivered by Dr. Premila Lee, Professor and Head of Medical Surgical Nursing, former Nursing Superintendent, and former Head of Surgical Nursing who is retiring after 39 years of illustrious service in the field of nursing and in whose honour this conference was held. The conference was attended by more than 400 nurses from 8 states of our country.

This Conference highlighted the nurses' role in 'Prehabilitation' and 'Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS), which have great implications on the patient outcomes. Patient safety, prevention of hospital infection, management of complex post-operative problems, comprehensive holistic quality nursing care and role of research in enhancing surgical care were some of the scientific sessions led by distinguished and expert surgeons and nurses, namely Dr. Inian Samarasam, Professor & Head of Surgery, CMC Vellore, Prof. Dr. Bindhu Mathew, Dean of Nursing, Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Dr. Rohin Mittal, Professor, Colorectal Surgery, CMC Vellore and Global Surgery Initiative Lead, India; Prof. Dr. E. Devakirubai, Vice Principal, Sacred Heart Nursing College, Madurai; Dr. Rajat Raghunath, Associate Professor, Colorectal Surgery unit, Prof. Dr. Rohini. T, Principal, Institute of Nursing Science and Research, Malabar Cancer Center, Thalassery, Mrs. Stephiny Lukose, Head and Neck Speciality Nurse, Mrs. Suganthi, Upper GI Speciality Nurse and Mrs. Latha Madan, M.Sc. Tutor and Stoma Nurse Specialist.

The Conference ended on a winning note as the winners of the competitive scientific oral and poster presentation were awarded prizes by Dr. Premila Lee. The feedback from the delegates was highly encouraging and it was felt that such conferences played a major role in upgrading knowledge of nurses, impacting nursing practice and contributing to better surgical patient outcomes.







# **CRE on Cosmetic Restoration in Upper & Lower Extremity Protheses**

Prosthetic & Orthotic (P&O) Services, Department of PMR conducted a Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) Hands-on workshop on "Cosmetic restoration of upper & lower extremity prostheses" supported by International Committee of the Red Cross, New Delhi from 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2023. The CRE was organised to design cosmetic restoration prostheses for patients with partial hand, partial foot, both upper and lower extremity finger amputations due to Diabetes Mellitus, Peripheral vascular diseases, trauma, and road traffic accidents. Cosmetic restoration prostheses play vital role in rehabilitation by restoring the function of lost segment and boosts psychological domain of the patient improving natural aesthetic appearance. Thus, it encourages the patient for social interactions by creating greater body image.

The CRE was aimed to train eight P & O professionals from different campuses of CMC and mission hospitals. The CRE was inaugurated by Dr. I. Rajesh, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal, Mr. Navid Dadbin, PRP Manager, ICRC, New Delhi, Mr. Saravanan, DDAWO, Vellore and Dr. Jacob George, Professor and Head of PMR. We had our resource person-cum-lead trainer Ms. Suman Singh, Head of Cosmetic Restoration, Ideal Artificial Limbs Solution, New Delhi, Hands-on training on various topics provisioning to the needs of P & O professionals were discussed. The training programme was intense throughout the four days and kept the participants intrigued.



# Celebration of World ORS Week

The College of Nursing, CMC Vellore Chittoor Campus celebrated the World ORS Week from 24th to 29th July. The theme for this year was The Amrut in Dehydration. An awareness programme on diarrohea prevention and management including identification of dehydration among children and rehydration at home by giving ORS fluids was continuously imparted to the parents of children attending the Paediatric OPD and those admitted in the Paediatric wards by the Nursing students. As part of the commemoration of the event there were essay and slogan competitions organised by Mrs. Anbarasi, Nurse Manager, Paediatric Nursing Department. Staff and students of Chittoor campus participated and the winners were awarded certificates and prizes.

On 29th July, 2023 the valedictory programme was organised at the patient waiting area of the Paediatric OPD. Dr. Premila Doss, Paediatrician was the chief guest of the programme who addressed the gathering and created awareness about management of dehydration and the importance of ORS in treating dehydration. Dr. Reginald Alex, Medicine Consultant was the guest of honour who also through real life examples provoked the minds of the people gathered and emphasised the importance of ORS for children with acute diarrheal infection. All the participants were introduced to topics like Designing Curriculum, Teaching Learning Strategies, Project Planning, Educational Research, Assessment learning, Skills training, Educational Scholarship, Quality Assurance, Conflict Management, Leadership, Managing Change, and Mentoring. The sessions were designed to involve all participants with activities in small groups.

It was a challenge in conducting the poster presentations for the contact course II participants on 28th July 2023 where the seniors presented their posters in the small groups and the juniors presented the senior's projects work in the large group.
