


Cochrane Systematic Reviews Workshop

The Cochrane India CMC Vellore Affiliate ran a 5-day workshop on 'Systematic Reviews, GRADE and Evidence to Decision' between the 21st and 25th August, 2023. The workshop was inaugurated by the sponsor of the Cochrane CMC Vellore Affiliate, Dr. Solomon Sathishkumar, Principal, Ms.Saramma Kuruvilla, Chaplain, led in prayer. The workshop was attended by 64 participants from all over India. The workshop covered review questions, InSynQ, protocol development, risk of bias 2.0, Zotero, literature search, data collection, data analysis, Revman, GRADE as well as Evidence to decision. The sessions were a mix of teaching as well as practical hands-on time. A special session on OVID Medline in systematic search was also conducted. The resource faculty included Dr. Prathap Tharyan, Dr. Sathish Kumar, Dr. Mohan

CME on Thyroid Disorders

The **Departments of Endocrinology and Continuing Medical Education** organised a **CME on Thyroid Disorders** on the 26th August, 2023.

Dr. Kripa Elizabeth Cherian explained how pregnancy affects thyroid function and the management of Graves' Disease in different stages of pregnancy and before conception. Dr. Dukhabandhu Naik from JIPMER, Puducherry,



stressed the increased risk of atrial fibrillation and cardiovascular mortality with subclinical hyperthyroidism, summarised research evidence, and provided guidelines for managing subclinical hyperthyroidism.

Dr. Johns T. Johnson provided a clear evidence-based approach to the common problems of subclinical hypothyroidism in different clinical scenarios. Dr. Jinson Paul illustrated the management of thyroid emergencies through a series of practical case scenarios. The CME Department thanks the Department of Endocrinology, Dr. Felix Jebasingh, the moderator, the speakers and the Telemedicine team.

Prosthetic and Orthotic Services share the information on Secondary Hospital Posting (SHP)

The **Prosthetic and Orthotic Services (P&O) team** from CMC Vellore recently conducted a **secondary hospital posting (SHP) as part of their Bachelor in Prosthetics and Orthotics (BPO) course.** The team consisted of three faculty members, two interns, and five BPO final year students. During the posting, they visited The Leprosy Mission Hospital in Naini and Faizabad.

At The Leprosy Mission Hospital in Naini, Dr. Premal Das, Executive Director of TLM, gave an orientation on various surgical interventions for leprosy rehabilitation. The team also had the opportunity to tour the hospital and learn about the prevalence and care for persons with leprosy in India. Mr. Babu, Physiotherapist and Mr. Madhan, Occupational Therapist provided further information on the services offered at TLM Naini.

In Faizabad, Mr. Bino Berry, Superintendent of TLM and Mr. Martin, Prosthetist and Orthotist, organised a five-day 'Disability Camp' in which persons with disabilities (PwD) in and around TLM Faizabad participated. The CMC P&O Team assessed each individual and fabricated various prostheses and orthoses, including Transtibial Prostheses, KAFO with height compensation Prostho Orthosis, Bilateral AFOs, Hand Splints, Trans Radial, Through Knee Prosthesis, and Silicone Partial Hand Prosthesis. The TLM Faizabad will follow up with the participants for regular therapy. We also had a community visit in TLM Faizabad and toured the vocational training centre.

The CMC P&O team expresses gratitude towards the TLM administration for accommodating them and conducting such a live camp activity, which benefited their final-year students. They also thank the Department of Missions at CMC Vellore for connecting them with The Leprosy Mission (TLM).
