Dr. Paul Ravindran retires



Dr. Paul Ravindran began his journey with CMC way back in 1986 with the Department of Radiotherapy. Since then he has been an active member and solely responsible for the various developments within the department. His great passion for teaching and his interactive style of delivering lectures in Radiological Physics and Medical Physics to the UG and PG students of Radiation Oncology and Radiotherapy Technology, made him a professor much loved by his students. He took special interest in teaching Radiobiology, Brachytherapy and Physics of

Radiation therapy with emphasis on computation methods for treatment planning.

In the year 2001, Dr. Paul had worked with London Regional Cancer Programme, London. Following which on his return to CMC, started a two-year residency programme in Medical Physics similar to the one in Canada, which was the first of its kind in India. This residency programme also gained acceptance from the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).

A special mention was made at the award ceremony that CMC Vellore has the highest number of highly cited papers amongst all professional colleges and the 3rd highest category normalized citation impact that was 1.5 times the world average for the period 2012 to 2018. Dr. Paul Ravindran retires

In 2011, Dr. Paul Ravindran was responsible for starting the three-year Master's Programme (M.Sc.) in Medical Physics in affiliation with the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University. In the same year, he also established a laboratory exclusively for students of Medical Physics equiped to perform basic science experiments, such as determination of half value layer, attenuation coefficient and gamma spectrum of radio isotopes. He also developed an imaging lab, with a bench top x-ray Cone Beam CT for imaging experiments and small computer lab for technical computing under a grant from the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India. The other lab he developed was for Gel dosimetry with facility for preparing FX and LCV gel and Optical cone beam CT for reading the radiation dose embedded in the Gel matrix.

Apart from being an inspiration within the department, he has been in various administrative positions in the institution. From 2008 to 2010, he was a member of the administrative committee and from 2010 to 2014 he headed the Department of Medical Records and was the Vice Principal (AHS) during the same time. From 2017, he has been serving as the Associate General Superintendent. Outside the institution, he is the Convener and Secretary of the Medical Radiation Technology Training Committee of the Christian Medical Association of India from 2005. He was also a member of the board and the executive committee of SIHR & TC, Hospital Karigiri. He has also held various honorary positions, such as, the Chief Examiner of College of Medical Physics of India, Member of Editorial Board , Journal of Medical Physics, member of project review committee in TDDP. He has tremendous experience in academic, clinical and research activities and has been involved in numerous projects as the principal investigator. Dr. Paul is well known for his expertise in teaching. He has been a mentor for many in their academic and personal lives. His wife, Dr. Vinitha Ravindran is the Professor & Head of Continuing Nursing Education and their daughter, Ms. Sharon Paul is a Psychologist working for an NGO at Bangalore.
