Indian Coral Tree

**Common name:** Indian Coral Tree **Botanical name:** *Erythrina varigata* 

Family: Faboideae

Name in Tamil: Kalyana murungai







**Field identification:** Medium sized, fast growing tree with straight trunk.. Branchlets armed with conical prickles up to  $3^{rd}$  or  $4^{th}$  year. Bark thin, yellowish-greenish-grey, smooth, with longitudinal whitish cracks, peeling off in flakes. Leaf with 3 leaflets with 13 cm long stalk with terminal leaflet largest 10-15cm 9-13 cm. Flowers large 5-6.3 x 2.5-3.8 cm, bright scarlet, 30 cm long clusters at the end of branchlets. Pods black, beaked, constricted between seeds
