Krishna Siris

**Common names:** Krishna Siris, **Botanical name:** *Albezia amara* 

**Family:** Fabaceae **Name in Tamil:** *Wunja* 











Field identification: Small to moderate-sized, much-branched deciduous tree with smooth, dark green, scaly bark.

Resembles the acacias but lacks thorns. Leaves are pinnately compound, with 15-24 pairs of small, linear leaflets, on 6-15 pairs of pinnae. Flowers yellow, pedicled, fragrant and 12-20 globose in clusters. Fruits oblong pods, about 10-28 x 2-5 cm, light brown, thin, and 6-8 seeded; seeds flattened, 8-13 x 7-8 mm
