Mahogany

Common name: Mahogany, Cuban Mahogany, American Mahogany

Botanical name: Swietenia macrophylla

Family: Meliaceae

Name in Tamil: Ciminukku, Mahagony, Nukkamaram







Field identification: Mediumsized semi-evergreen tree, up to 30-35m. Bark grey and smooth turning furrowed with age.
Leaves pinnate 12-25 cm long, with 4-8 leaflets. Leaflets 5-6 cm x 2-3 cm, no terminal leaflet.
Flowers small, panicle. Fruit woody capsule 5-10cm x 3-6 cm with numerous winged seeds.
