Mango Tree

Common name: Mango Tree **Botanical name:** *Mangifera indica*

Family: Anacardiaceae **Name in Tamil:** *Mamaram*









Field identification: Large tree with dome shaped crown. Bark rough, thick, dark grey and fibrous. Leaves, crowded at end of branches, oblong or lance shaped, 10-30 x 2-10 cm, dark glossy green, pinkish when young. Flowering shoots conical. Fleshy fruit 5-20 cm, yellow when ripe.

Location on campus: in many residential compounds.
