Sapota

Common name: Sapota, Chikku

Botanical name: Manilkara zapota; Family: Sapotaceae; Name in Tamil: Sappota









Field identification: height usually 9- 15 m, trunk diameter less then 50 cm. Bark has a white, gummy latex. Leaves green and glossy, alternate, elliptic to ovate, 7– 15 cm with an entire margin. Flowers white, inconspicuous, bell-like, with a six-lobed corolla. Fruit, large berry, 4– 8 cm, flesh pale yellow to brown color. Seeds hard, glossy, black, resembling beans.

Location on campus: In many residential gardens. E.g Scudder crescent.
