<u>Scholar Tree</u> Common name: Scholar Tree, Devil's Tree Botanical name: *Alstonia scholaris* Family: Apocynaceae Name in Tamil: *Pala* 



**Field identification:** Large, evergreen tree, often fluted or buttressed. Bark grey. Branches whorled, exude milky latex when cut. Leaves whorled 7.5-20 x 2.5-3.7 cm, oblong-lance-shaped, round or notched. Lateral nerves parallel uniting at margin in a distinct vein. Flowers, small, greenish white in clusters.
