Childneurocon 2024

Childneurocon 2024, the 14th Annual Conference of the Association of Child Neurology (AOCN), India was held from 8th to 10th February 2024 at the Scudder auditorium and examination hall, Bagayam, Vellore. The conference was organized by the Department of Neurological Sciences. Day one had five preconference workshops in 5 different streams namely Paediatric Sleep medicine, Paediatric Epilepsy syndromes, Neuroelectrophysiology, Neurodevelopment and Behavioural Pediatrics and Neuroradiology. Each of these workshops was put together by eminent convenors and saw 373 participants. The main conference over the next two days had symposia and discussions led by international and national experts in the field. The conference saw the convergence of 15 international faculty, more than 90 national faculty and over 600 delegates from across the country and from the neighbouring Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Nepal. The delegates included all associated with child neurology—paediatric neurologists, paediatricians, geneticists, neuroscientists, developmental paediatricians, child psychiatrists, occupational and physiotherapists, technologists, and educationists. This involvement cemented the theme for our conference 'Collaboration the means to creativity'. The conference also gave an opportunity for young researchers to put up their work as e posters and platform presentations and saw nearly 275 abstracts.

The conference had two orations – the AOCN oration delivered by Dr. Radha Rama Devi, a pioneer in the field of genetics on 'Journey of Genomics – yesterday, today and tomorrow' and the Vellore oration delivered by Professor Mathew Alexander, neurologist and former head of the department of Neurological Sciences, CMC, Vellore on 'Coming of age..., emphasizing the importance of transition care in individuals with chronic illness. The inauguration had Prof. Vedantam Rajshekhar, neurosurgeon and former head of the department of Neurological Sciences, CMC, Vellore as the guest of honour who delivered a thought-provoking address which highlighted that research publications need to speak the whole truth and benefit individuals, so that medical professionals will continue to be trusted by people. The inauguration was followed by an extraordinary cultural event 'Moods and Movements', a dance medley put together by Avigna Dance Ensemble, Chennai.
