**Situations Vacant** 

The World Health Organization observes March 3<sup>rd</sup> as World Hearing Day to raise awareness on the prevention of hearing loss and to promote ear and hearing health across the world. The WHO theme for this year was "Changing mindsets: Let's Make Ear and Hearing Care a Reality for all". The Department of ENT Unit-IV and staff and students from audiology organised an awareness camp on March 6<sup>th</sup> in the Town Campus to create awareness on the importance of caring for one's ears, preventing hearing loss and hearing rehabilitation for the overall health and well-being of an individual. The event was inaugurated by Dr Vikram Mathews, Director, CMC Vellore and Rev. Paul Ravikumar led the prayer of dedication.

Various stalls addressing different aspects of hearing care, such as prevention and rehabilitation of hearing loss, were set up. The community was educated through colourful and informative posters on topics such as, how we hear, common ear diseases, the hazards of noise exposure, the importance of hearing assessment and ear care.

Various options for hearing rehabilitation were highlighted, using models and posters. Recent advances in hearing rehabilitation such as cochlear implants and other implantable hearing devices were explained with the help of models and videos. A mime performed by postgraduates in ENT on the problems associated with hearing loss, the need for rehabilitation and measures for ear care was displayed.

Doctors, audiology staff and students individually provided counsel to staff, students, patients and their relatives on measures to prevent hearing loss as they walked through the stalls. Pamphlets and ear care stickers were distributed to the public. Hundreds of people queued for free ear checkups, and many patients with ear problems were identified and advised accordingly.



## Workshop conducted by Distance Education Unit

Distance Education Unit along with International Christian Medical and Dental Association ICMDA ran a three-day workshop that focused on the principles of writing self-learning modules which will form the course content. The workshop was organised at Yelagiri from 29th February to 3rd March 2024. During the workshop, the 22 participants were given protected time to write the first draft of their respective modules. The Distance Education unit will continue to support the authors in their writing process. This workshop was conducted as a part of the International Blended Learning Course in Healthcare Management which the Distance Education Unit will launch in the first quarter of 2025, along with the International Christian Medical and Dental Association (ICMDA) and Loma Linda University, USA.



#### Virtual Course on Research Methods

The Department of CNE & Research, College of Nursing, CMC Vellore organised a virtual course on Research Methods including both basic and advanced levels over a week from 4th to 8th March, 2024. The Course commenced with prayer and welcome by Dr. Vinitha Ravindran, Dean, College of Nursing, CMC Vellore. The objective of the course was to update on basic & advanced research designs, understand methods and methodological rigour, explore ways and means of research dissemination and apply ethics related to research & publication. A total of 51 participants including PhD scholars, faculty, and PG students actively participated in the sessions. The sessions were covered by faculty from Nursing, Medical & Biostatistics from CMC, Vellore and Sathyabama College of Nursing, Chennai. The course content was presented using interactive lectures, panel discussions and hands-on training on scientific literature search, Zotero reference management and SPSS data entry and analysis.

## 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Renal Symposium, 16<sup>th</sup> Renal Clinical Conference

The 7th Annual Renal Symposium (Renal Transplant Infections) and the 16th Renal Clinical Conference were held on the 19th & 20th of January, 2024 in the New Examination Hall, College Campus, Bagayam. The objective of the symposium was to provide postgraduate trainees and consultants in Nephrology, Medicine, and Paediatrics an update on the pathogenesis, diagnosis latest treatment guidelines and development in the field of transplant infections, especially DM and DNB Nephrology trainees who are preparing for their practical exit examination. It involved casework and presentations by the trainees with extensive interactive discussions as well as a session on interesting radiology findings in renal transplantation. The international faculty was Prof. George T. John senior consultant, Department of Renal Medicine Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital. Dr. John was the former Head of the Department of Nephrology CMC Vellore. The national faculty were Prof. Chakko K. Jacob from Bengaluru, Prof. Anuradha Raman and Prof Swarnalatha from Hyderabad, Prof. Abhijit Tarphder from Kolkata, Prof. Tukaram Jamale from Mumbai, Prof. N. Gopalakrishnan Prof. Edwin Fernando and Dr. Subramaniyan Swaminathan from Chennai, Prof. Gomathi S from Aleppey and Prof. Priyamvada PS from Puducherry. The intramural faculty for the programme were Prof. Priscilla Rupali, and Dr. Abi Manesh from Infectious Disease, Dr. Antony Augustine from Radiology and Dr. Santosh Varughese from Nephrology. The 2-day programme was endorsed by the International Society of Nephrology, Indian Society of Nephrology and Indian Society of Organ Transplantation and carried 15 CME credit points from the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University and 4 credit hours from Tamil Nadu Medical Council. The event started with prayer at 9:30 am and felicitations by Dr. Vinoi G. David, Head of the Nephrology department, Prof. Chakko K. Jacob former head of the department of Nephrology, Dr. Suceena Alexander Vice-Principal, and Dr. Abi Manesh Deputy Medical Superintendent. 

#### **Obituaries**

• **Dr. Vijai Prakash Daniel** (MBBS batch of 1970), passed away on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2024. Dr. Vijai Prakash Daniel (fondly called VPD by his batch mates) was born on June 1, 1953 to Mr. C J Daniel and Mrs. Elizabeth Daniel as the 6<sup>th</sup> of 6 children. His father was a pioneer in pineapple cultivation, processing and canning, and his mother a school teacher who gave up her job to take care of her own children.



After completing his schooling and pre-degree in Trichur he joined the Christian Medical College, Vellore in 1970. In an interview given to the Kerala Society of Ophthalmic Surgeons in June 2023, he spoke about how Dr. M.C. Modi – an Ophthalmologist from Bangalore – would come every year to Trichur to conduct eye camps. Dr. Vijai Prakash was a volunteer at these camps from Class 6, for four years – and decided he wanted to be an Ophthalmologist – and becoming a doctor was the route to achieving his dream.

During his college days Dr. Vijai Prakash was elected the Mess Secretary in his first year, and then the Class Representative in his second year. In his third year he became the Mess Secretary of Men's Hostel – and his batchmates remember that year's Hostel Day dinner for two reasons – getting two of his classmates to travel to Chennai (then Madras) to buy 250 kilos of Pomfret (which they traveled back with on the Brindavan Express) and naming the chicken dish after one of the more attractive girls in his class (who, ironically enough was – and continues to be – a vegetarian).

He was also captain of Findlay House in his third year – and the fresher batch of that year remembers how he told them "Findlay House never gives up".

In the midst of these co-curricular activities, Dr. Vijai Prakash did a study on the beggars of Vellore – cycling around on a hired bicycle on Sundays – interviewing beggars in front of churches, temples, bus stops and around the CMC Hospital. He even sat with them, dressed as a beggar (though an overfed one!) to study and report on their lives. With his methodical and untiring approach this became a great survey and he won the Undergraduate Research Award that year.

After graduation and on completing his sponsorship obligation, Dr. Vijai Prakash went to GSVM Medical College, Kanpur to do his DOMS. Interestingly, on completing his DOMS he dabbled in real estate for a period of ten years – he had a timber estate in Pollachi in Tamil Nadu, and mulberry orchards in Bangalore (from where he would supply mulberry leaves to the silkworm rearers in Karnataka). At the end of ten years he decided to get back to practicing Ophthalmology; realizing he had been out of touch with this subject for a decade, he contacted Dr. Philip Kuruvilla (his senior from the MBBS batch of 1966) and went and trained under him in cataract surgery – spending a year with him at the GM Eye Hospital at Mettupalayam.

On returning to Trichur, he set up Sudarsanam Eye Care Centre in Wadakkanchery, where he and his wife Mrs. Anu had a house. He initially started doing his eye surgeries in a General surgery operation theater. When two of his patients developed eye infection, he decided he would operate only when he had his own clinic with a theater dedicated to eye surgeries. And so in 1999, Sutharia (the Malayalam word for "transparent") Eye Clinic came into being in Shoranur. From 1999 until 2011 he would work in Wadakkanchery in the mornings and in Shoranur in the afternoons.

He continued to keep himself updated with recent trends in Ophthalmology – and underwent training in small incision cataract surgery (in Aravind Eye Hospital at Coimbatore) and then in phacoemulsification (in Arasan Eye Hospital, Erode) – when he was about 50 years old – joking that this was probably one of the few times that the student was years older than the teachers.

Despite his packed work schedule he served as the President of TACO (Trichur Academic Club of Ophthalmology) and during that year Trichur got the State President's award for best Ophthalmic club. He was also instrumental in transforming Tacopsia – the newsletter of the Trichur Academic Club of Ophthalmology from a half page newsletter to a four page one.

He got married during his internship – and his wife Mrs. Anu and he lived in a house near the college campus. His house was always open to friends and batchmates – who loved Mrs. Anu's cooking and enjoyed the warmth of the couple's friendship. Mrs. Anu was a huge source of support when he set up Sutharia Eye Clinic – in the early years she would help with the accounts, indenting for equipment and supervising the laundry. The couple had two sons – Ajai and Vinu. Ajai died in a tragic road accident – and Dr. Vijai Prakash was the model of courage and dignity during this devastating period in their lives. Vinu worked as a software engineer for many years – and now has his own automobile business in Trichur. Vinu is married, and has two children – a daughter and a son, born a few days before Dr. Vijai Prakash passed away.

With the excellent patient care, and affordable fee structure his clinics attracted patients from all parts of Kerala. He upheld the college motto of "Not to be Ministered Unto, but to Minister" with his expertise, his sincerity and dedication, and above all his humility.

He continued to keep himself up to date with recent developments in his specialty, attending conferences regularly and reading voraciously. His deep love for his batch mates ensured he attended all the alumni reunions of the batch.

At 60 years of age Dr. Vijai Prakash was told by his family that he should retire – there were other Ophthal-mologists in his clinic who were carrying on his good work. He took this advice – and after a month of being at home told his wife and son that this lifestyle would drive him crazy – and that he was returning to work. He went back to Sudarsanam Eye Care Centre, and continued being involved in whole hearted patient care; working Monday to Friday at Wadakkanchery. Weekends were at home in Trichur with his family and especially enjoying time with his granddaughter.

He had booked a holiday in Pelling (Sikkim) in April to be high in the Himalayas – but God had other plans for him and has taken him to a higher place. He died in his sleep on February 26, 2024 – active until the very end, which is what he would have probably wanted.

In an interview given to the Kerala Society of Ophthalmic Surgeons his advice to the younger generation of Ophthalmologists was "advancements in medicine are constantly taking place, so keep reading and updating your knowledge; remember education never stops."

Dr. Vijai Prakash Daniel will live on in the hearts of his many friends (from his school days onward to now), his immediate and large extended family, his patients, and his batch mates from CMC Vellore. We, your batch mates will greatly miss you dear VPD – your love, your smile, and the cheer you always brought.
