Christian Medical College Vellore has successfully procured the Inauguration of the Hyperfine Hyperfine Swoop Low-field Portable MRI Scanner, making it the first hospital in the country to have this state-of-the-art equipment. The Hyperfine Swoop scanner produces a magnetic field of only 0.064 T, making it not only safer but also more energy-efficient than traditional MRI machines. With a power consumption of just 900w, equivalent to that of a coffee machine, the low-field scanner does not require cryogens. The scanner is easily portable and can be moved from one facility to another, even to the patient's bedside, using joystick control. Equipped with advanced image processing and deep learning algorithms, it can produce high-quality MRI images. Currently, the Hyperfine MRI scanner is approved for research use in the country. The dedication and inauguration was conducted on 23rd March 2024 at the CODES Building, Sathumadurai. After the opening prayer by Rev. Rachita Raut, Dr.Beena Koshy, Professor, of Developmental Paediatrics welcomed the gathering. Felicitation was offered by Dr. Vinod Joseph Abraham -Vice Principal (UG), who inaugurated the facility. Dignitaries present included Dr.Venkat Raghava Mohan, Professor and Head of, the Community Health Department, Dr. Samuel Philip Oommen, Professor and Head of developmental Paediatrics. Dr.Pavithra Mannam, Professor, Radiology, and Dr. Anne George, Professor, OBG. Rev. Rachita Rout dedicated the Hyperfine MRI scanner for the glory of God. On 6th April, 2024, the Department of Anaesthesia held a Regional Anaesthesia CME, Live Interactive Scanning and Cadaveric Workshop at the New Examination Hall, and Anatomy Dissection Hall, Bagayam. The event aimed to highlight the importance of adhering to best practices in Regional Anaesthesia to equip all categories of practitioners with the necessary knowledge and skills to deliver high-quality care while minimizing risks and ensuring safe and scientific practices. The programme provided a forum for participants to share their experiences and learn from each other, ultimately advancing the utility of Regional Anaesthesia in perioperative care. The scientific session included a series of short lectures by internal and external faculty, followed by a cadaveric workshop where anatomists demonstrated the gross anatomy pertaining to Regional Anaesthesia. State Level Workshop Organised by College of Nursing, CMC Vellore



The Departments of Neurology Nursing, and CNE & Research, College of Nursing conducted a state level workshop on 'Nursing Care of Patients With Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) And Spinal Cord Injury (SCI)' on March 22, 2024. A total of 44 delegates from within and outside the institution participated . The objectives of the workshop were to enable participants to acquire in-depth knowledge of traumatic brain and spinal cord injuries, identify and manage TBI and SCI patients efficiently, demonstrate skills in managing TBI and SBI, and appreciate legal and ethical concerns related to trauma.

The sessions were covered by the faculty from the Departments of Neurology CMC Vellore and Neurology Nursing from College of Nursing, CMC Vellore; School of Nursing, Scudder Memorial Hospital, and Apollo Hospitals, Chennai. The session were on the following topics:

- Injury classification and presentation of symptoms of TBI & SCI,
- Basics of increased ICP & management of TBI diffuse axonal injury,
- Brain death protocol,
- Legal and ethical concerns related to trauma,
- Assessment of patient following TBI & SCI,
- Primary & secondary prevention of TBI & SCI.

There were sessions on Neurorehabilitation, ICP monitoring, skull traction & log roll technique and prevention & management of complications (Tabletop exercise). The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 7 credit points for the workshop.
