# Patients with Rheumatological Disorders and Nursing Management- An Update



The Rheumatology Nursing Specialty and Department of CNE & Research, College of Nursing conducted a state-level workshop on 'Patients with Rheumatological Disorders and Nursing Management-An Update' on April 26th, 2024. A total of 42 delegates from within and outside the institution participated in the workshop. The objectives of the workshop were to enable participants to improve the awareness of nurses on rheumatological disorders, demonstrate skills in caring for patients with rheumatological disorders, and sensitise the nurses to provide evidence-based nursing care for patients with rheumatological disorders.

The sessions were covered by the faculty from the Departments of Rheumatology & Immunology from CMC Vellore, Rheumatology Nursing speciality, College of Nursing, CMC Vellore, School of Nursing, Dr. Mehta's Hospitals, Chetpet, Chennai and Velammal Medical College Hospital and Research Institute, Madurai. The topics included were an overview of systemic sclerosis, SLE & vasculitis in IP setting, motivational counselling, rheumatoid arthritis, Raynaud's phenomenon & panel discussion on care of patients with rheumatological disorders. Skill sessions included assisting with renal biopsy/ lip biopsy, auto immune diet, assisting for intra-articular injection, loading and administration of biologics (Inj.Rituximab), physiotherapy and occupational therapy for patients with rheumatological disorders. The Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council awarded 7 credit points for the workshop.
