Institutional Research Methodology Workshop

Obituaries

Dr. Vimala Isaac (*nee* Muthiah) (MBBS batch of 1954), passed away on 8th May, 2024. She was born in 1934, at Bangalore, to Rev. P.A. Muthiah and Mrs. Grace Padma. Being the eldest of five siblings, she was a born leader, always protecting her siblings. Dr. Vimala did her schooling in Secunderabad and Hyderabad. She completed her matriculation from Stanley Methodist Girls' School, achieving the highest marks, to become the state topper. In recognition of this, she was awarded the Gokhale scholarship by the government. Upon completion of her Intermediate exam from the Womens' Christian College, Madras, she joined the Christian Medical College Vellore in 1954.



At college, Dr. Vimala was proficient in academics and sports. She was also a member of the choir and additionally enjoyed singing Hindi and Telugu movie songs for the College programs. She excelled at sports and was on the Tamil Nadu netball team. Additionally, she participated in track and field events. While in college, Vimala, along with her accomplices Sara, Padma, Saro, Katy, Amy and a couple of other classmates would hook off on Sundays on cycling trips, down Arni road to have picnics; fortified by bread and fried chicken cooked by the hostel mess "thambis", sworn to secrecy with a little "financial" incentive. Dr. Vimala was very attractive, with her ready dimpled smile, the epitome of style. She had many a "hopeful" suitor, but in the course of her housemanship, while doing her anaesthesia posting, destiny intervened. With his sharp wit and charming ways, Dr. Martin Isaac her senior (batch of 1951) gained her interest. They married in 1962 and embarked on a life of adventure.

Her sense of style, elegant way of dressing and her figure of eight bun held greatly appealed to her little niece. Sometimes her nephews, on the pretext of visiting Dr. Vimala, would be allowed into the LIQ, where they would surreptitiously cast their lines to hook the gold fish in the Lily pond. Dr. Vimala with her great sense of humour would laugh at their antics when they were caught, instead of giving them a dressing down. Dr. Vimala joined the department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at CMC and worked under Drs. Manuel and Paranjothi. She went on to do her DGO and MD degrees at the Institute for Women and Children at Egmore, Madras, training under the famous Dr. A.L. Mudaliar. Later she completed her MRCOG and was conferred the FRCOG. She was a skilled surgeon who inspired her students to do their best. To quote one of her students "she made it all so easy, as she broke Obs and Gyne into very simple modules. She demanded a high standard from her department; she led by example." Dr. Vimala was an excellent cook and a gracious hostess, always kept a highly organised and beautiful home. There were many times when Dr. Martin and his nephews would be busted by her while trying to sneak a smoke or for some other misdemeanors and would be verbally flogged. Both her household and the OG department thrived under her iron hand in the velvet glove. Dr. Vimala had a serious side to her nature as well. She was an advocate of justice, a fearless champion of the underdog, no matter the consequences. In 1974, Drs. Vimala and Martin Isaac's journey of adventure took them to the Kasturba Medical College at Manipal, where they joined as faculty.

They made immense contributions to the growth of their respective departments and to their medical trainees. While in Manipal, Dr. Vimala faced one of her life's greatest challenges. She had boarded a bus from Bangalore to Manipal.

During the night, negotiating a hairpin bend, the driver lost control of the bus and it plunged twenty feet down a cliff into a deep gorge. Upon receiving the news, Dr. Martin and a team rushed to the accident spot and carried her up the steep slope to the waiting ambulance. There were many casualties among the other passengers. She had numerous cuts and lacerations over the face and a cervical spine injury which required immobilisation for a few weeks. She was hospitalised for three months for intense rehabilitation. With great determination, grit, support from her family and God's miraculous touch, she recovered without any paralysis or residual issues.

She returned to her rigorous schedule of teaching, surgery and consultations speedily and never looked back. Drs. Vimala and Martin embarked on their next venture, to Papua New Guinea, where they were appointed as professors at the University of Papua New Guinea, Medical School. While they were there, their daughter Geeta completed her medical training. Their last stint was at Brunei, after which they retired and made Chennai their home. They continued helping at various mission hospitals and spent time renewing their ties with family and friends. Ever helpful, caring, organising family events and supporting various sick family members.

On one occasion, while visiting their nephew and niece in Delhi, they enthusiastically accompanied them to the disco. Since liquor was quite expensive at the disco, Dr. Vimala was chosen to smuggle in a couple of bottles under her thick winter jacket! They were both great sports. After a couple of years in India, realising the need to live nearer to their only daughter, they finally put down their roots in Canberra, Australia. Where they were surrounded by the love, care and support of Geeta and her family and enjoyed the company of their granddaughters Danielle and Sanchia, in their sunset years. On 8.5.2024, Dr. Vimala went home to be with her Lord. The funeral and interment were held on 16.5.2024 at Canberra. She was an amazingly talented woman, a multifaceted lady, but above all a God fearing, humane person who impacted the lives of family, friends and students. An inspiration to many. Dr. Annie Chandra Nesaraj (nee Annie Chandra Bai) (MBBS batch of 1944), passed away on 17th May, 2024.

She was born on 12 January 1927 as the second child amongst eight siblings. The eldest is late Rev. Watson and youngest is Dr. A. N. Henry. She came from a family of famous pastors and pioneers on both sides. She joined the MBBS course at CMC Vellore in 1944, She personally knew and was greatly influenced by the founder of CMC – Dr. Ida Scudder.

She was influenced by Dr Scudder's missionary ethos that drove her entire life. She excelled academically and received several medals throughout her medical school years. One day, when she could not attend class, one of her professors even refused to start a new topic saying, "the cream of the class is missing".

She fondly remembered the activities while she was in Vellore that included regular village medical mission and prison visits. After a year each in Madurai Medical Mission and in Jaffna, Sri Lanka she settled in her native Kanyakumari district for the rest of her working life. While working in Azhagiyamandapam, she used to walk down paddy fields to help in the delivery of babies for women in their huts who refused to come to hospital with just an assistant and very minimal resources compared to today's standards.

She started working in Nagercoil Mission Hospital and stayed there till she retired. She used to say people discouraged her from working there as the hospital had been shut soon after it started. Some saying the Tamil verse "Patta marram thulirkuma?" which has now turned into a thriving institution in Nagercoil that she was always proud of.

After retirement, she joined Dr. Jeyasekharan Hospital and worked into her early 80s. She enjoyed working and making friends with generations of young doctors and mentoring them. She was totally independent till her 90th birthday living by herself in her Nagercoil family house at Joshua Street. She was married to late Mr Nesaraj and is mother to Late Dr. Vasantha Nesaraj, Dr Harrison Nesaraj and Dr Anitha John. Dr. Harrison and his wife Dr. Chandini had the blessing of having Dr. Annie live with them for the last 7 years of her life in their home in Trivandrum. Though she missed Nagercoil, she kept saying Trivandrum is where it all started as she had her entire schooling at Trivandrum where her father worked at the secretariat.

She was never seen upset or angry, she was always grateful for everything and everyone with absolute contentment even amid difficulties. She was kind and compassionate. She had a strong faith expressed through her actions of kindness that touched several generations. She used to tell often quote her mentors Motto “Whatever work you do, do your best as you are working for God, and He is your ultimate paymaster”.

Even in her later years, she kept herself busy colouring picture books and presenting them to her grandchildren with words of wisdom for their keep. She kept reading the Bible cover to cover and was thrilled to learn new things. She was a source of joy and wisdom to many. Having completed her work here on earth, she is now at peace in God’s presence whom she served in so many ways. She was an anchor and larger than life figure to us children and grandchildren as well as her sibling.
