The Reception Room in the Scudder Auditorium was a gift from the descendants of the 5 brothers of our founder, Dr. Ida S. Scudder- John, Lewis, Charles, Harry, and Walter. It was dedicated and inaugurated on December 9, 1966, her 96th birth anniversary. The Room was furnished with furniture Current Concepts in Osteosynthesis from Hill Top, Dr. Ida's beloved home in Kodaikanal, creating a personal connection to her life. Later, her degrees and other items were added, further enriching the historicity of the Reception Room.

> The Reception Room is used during Graduation and other Institutional events- Presidents, Governors, and other eminent personalities have been hosted in the Reception Room.

> As part of the renovation process, the old furniture was refurbished and similar new pieces were crafted with great care and beauty. The College Maintenance and the A.C. Section undertook the civil and engineering work, ensuring the structural integrity of the room. Dr. Ida's degrees were re-framed, and a new gallery of photos was added, each telling their own story of the timelessness of this iconic Auditorium.

The renovated Reception Room was dedicated by Rev. Dr. J Priestly Balasingh, President/Bishop of the Indian Evangelical Lutheran Church, and the Council Chairperson, Ms. Anuvinda Varkey, in the presence of the Council members on June 25th, 2024. We hope that the renovated Reception Room, with its elegance and historical significance, will continue to be a place of inspiration and reflection, speaking of the legacy and heritage of CMC, and that all who come through its doors will be blessed by the inspiring life and work of Dr. Ida S Scudder.

Current Concepts in Osteosynthesis (CCO) - Advanced 2024

The Department of Orthopaedics in association with the Trauma Orthopaedics Unit at Ranipet conducted a course on the 'Current Concepts in Osteosynthesis (CCO) - Advanced 2024'. This course has been conducted regularly since its establishment in 2004, with 40 delegates participating this year, including 8 delegates from the Government Medical College, Vellore. The course took place on the 20th and 21st of June, 2024. The course was carefully curated based on the world-renowned AO Trauma course, including didactic lectures, group discussions, and hands-on saw bone model workshops. The sessions were conducted by eminent faculty – Dr. Shailesh Pai (Senior Consultant, Tejasvini Hospital & SSIOT Mangalore and AO Trauma Faculty), Dr.Samuel Chittaranjan (Professor Emeritus, Believers Church Medical College, Kerala) and Dr. Gopisankar Balaji (Professor, JIPMER) and faculty from CMC Vellore.

For example, 'peaceful and assuring' in the OPD areas and 'contemplative and comforting' in the waiting areas outside wards. Artwork around the cafes and food booths reflects the 'kaapi-chai-kadai' scenes replicated across the nooks and corners of our country; chalkboard art with medical trivia provides an interesting read. Artwork by staff, students, and patients has been displayed as well.

The artwork was inaugurated by Council Chairperson, Ms. Anuvinda Varkey, and Rt. Rev. Dr. A.R. Chelliah, Bishop of the CSI Kanyakumari Diocese, on 25th June, 2024, in the presence of members of the Council Executive Committee. Each artwork is more than just aesthetics; it tells a story. We hope that each piece will speak to each innate need, uplift souls, and inspire.
