Report on the 5th Certificate Course in Infection Prevention and Control and Antimicrobial Stewardship



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The 5th certificate course on IPC & Antimicrobial Stewardship was successfully conducted from 15th to 19th July 2024, by the Hospital Infection Control Committee. 28 delegates took part in the course comprising a mélange of clinicians, microbiologists, pathologists, and nurses from, medical colleges, mission hospitals and private hospitals from Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Meghalaya, and Puducherry.

The course commenced with an inaugural function with an invocation by infection control nurses followed by prayer by Ms. Saramma Kuruvilla, Chaplain. Dr. Rajiv Karthik, the deputy chairman of HIC welcomed the gathering, while Dr. John Antony Jude Prakash, secretary of HIC, laid out the overview of the course. Dr. Ebby Simon, Associate Director, Medical and Dr. I Rajesh, the medical superintendent and chairperson of HICC, emphasized the need for strict adherence to infection prevention and control practices and the role of antibiotic stewardship in preventing healthcare-associated infections. Dr. Hema Paul, Physician and organising secretary HIC officer proposed the vote of thanks.

The objective of this course was to equip doctors in areas of infection control and antimicrobial stewardship with the tools and resources required for combating healthcare-associated infections and to enable those actively involved in infection control to freely exchange ideas and knowledge.

Participants gained valuable insights into the essential tools and resources necessary to combat Health Care Associated Infections (HCAIs). The five-day course featured diverse sessions covering specific aspects of hospital infection control, including patient safety, healthcare-associated infections, antimicrobial resistance and stewardship, infection control in specialized environments, and healthcare safety. This year we had three external faculties to enrich our learning.

Dr. Daniel Vander Ende, Medical Officer in the International Infection Control Branch at the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, discussed the importance of root cause analysis and hands-on sessions on planning a quality improvement activity in IPC.

Dr. Adimai Siromany Valan, a Public Health Specialist specializing in Infectious Diseases at the CDC, National office in New Delhi explained the steps involved in conducting an outbreak investigation through case studies and group discussions.

Dr. Malini R Capoor, Professor of Microbiology VMMC & SJH, New Delhi, took an online session highlighting the management of Biomedical Waste (BMW), including radioactive and e-waste.

During the course, the participants had the opportunity to visit the ICUs, CSSD in Town and Ranipet Campus, laundry, Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBMWTF) kandipedu and a few wards for hygiene rounds. The participants went through skill stations, to demonstrate competencies in hand hygiene, BMW segregation and donning & doffing of PPE. Skills such as handling and dressing central and peripheral lines, aseptic techniques while drawing a blood culture, and urinary catheterization were demonstrated. Participants learnt the technique of drawing blood samples using a Leur adapter & needle Central and peripheral line dressing was ably demonstrated by the line nurses' team. Laboratory method of doing AST and environment surveillance was demonstrated in the microbiology lab.

The workshop concluded on the 19th of July, 2024 with a valedictory ceremony. The report of the certificate course was presented by Dr. Hema Paul. Dr. Binila Chacko, Deputy Director and Dr. Abi Manesh, Deputy Medical Superintendent offered their felicitations and distributed certificates to the participants for completing the course. A vote of thanks was given by Mr. Senthamil Selvan. Ms. Jisha Susan Sabu, Chaplain, concluded the programme with a closing prayer.



















International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

College of Nursing, CMC Vellore Chittoor Campus:

The International Day against Drug Abuse and illicit trafficking is marked on 26th June every year to raise awareness about substance use and to strengthen initiatives to make the world drug-free. The theme for this year is "The evidence is clear; invest in prevention". In commemoration of this day, the College of Nursing, CMC Vellore Chittoor, Campus organised an awareness programme for college and school students of Chittoor. Dr. Pastin Pushpa Rani P, Professor of Nursing and Ms. Lin Maria Philip George, Nursing Tutor coordinated the event.

The first session was held at RK Vidyalaya Junior College. Dr. Dheeraj Kattula, Psychiatrist from the Department of Psychiatry, Christian Medical College Vellore addressed the students. He emphasised stress management, suicide prevention, coping strategies and prevention of substance use. This was followed by an interactive session during which students had an opportunity to discuss various matters related to mental health and stress management. Dr. Pastin Pushpa Rani P, nursing faculty of the College of Nursing interacted with the students and reinforced the importance of avoiding drug use. Mr. Ramesh Babu, Principal, of RK Vidyalaya Junior College honoured the speaker and encouraged students to seek help when needed.

The second session was planned in PCR Government School Chittoor, Mrs. Uma, Principal Assistant welcomed the speaker. Dr. Dheeraj spoke on the importance of establishing study habits, stress management and healthy ways of coping. Teachers and students from the school benefitted from the session. They raised questions which Dr. Dheeraj clarified. Ms. Lin Maria, Nursing Tutor of College of Nursing interacted with the students personally and clarified their queries.













Allergy Week Celebrations

The Department of Pulmonary Medicine organised events related to the "World Allergy Week 2024" at the CMC Vellore, Ranipet campus. CMC staff and students, as well as school students and teachers, participated in the various awareness events and competitions organised by the department. Around 600 students belonging to classes six and above from 22 schools in the Vellore district participated in the Art competition. Close to 2100 students viewed the online awareness lecture on food allergy in schools. In addition to the student art competition, 40 teachers from these schools attended a half-day workshop on managing allergies and asthma in schools. The hands-on training was provided on how to administer first aid in case of an allergy/asthma emergency. They were also taught how to collect relevant medical information from parents of children with allergies to help their wards attend a safe schooling environment. Medical students and staff of CMC also participated in the quiz and poster-making competitions.

The occasion helped the department to highlight the importance of the prevention and care of Allergic disorders. The prevalence of allergies and asthma has been increasing in India. Although the precise reason is unknown, many factors, including urbanization, changes in the environment and changes in dietary habits, are believed to play a part. The increase in food allergy is believed to be due to changes in dietary practices, such as the Western diet replacing the traditional Indian diet. The increase in respiratory allergy may be due to the increase in air pollution levels, particularly in urban areas. This event was an important opportunity to raise awareness and understanding of allergies, emphasising their impact on health and quality of life. This year's theme was "Overcoming Food Allergy Obstacles."

The valedictory function was held on 26th June 2024. Dr. T. Balamugesh introduced the significance of the celebration and appreciated Dr. Jefferson Daniel for planning all the activities. Dr. Reuban Thomas Kurien on behalf of MS Office and Ms. Jeyalinda on behalf of Nursing Service offered felicitations. This was followed by prize distributions. In the Asthma/Allergy quiz, Dr. John Roy Palathinkal won the first prize among doctors; Ms. Jeevitha and Ms. Vijayashanthi shared the first prize among staff.
