Christian Medical College (CMC) Vellore inaugurated its state-of-the-art Emergency Medical Services on July 18, 2024. The new facility was officially launched by the District Collector Tmt. V. R Subbulaxmi, I.A.S.

The EMS is run and managed by the Emergency Department (ED) and transport departments of CMC Vellore. The two 24x7 emergency helpline numbers are 9791979797 and 0416-228 2280. The two components of EMS are:

- Inter-hospital transfers including transfers between the various hospital campuses of CMC Vellore (CHAD, MHC, Rehab center, RUHSA, Schell eye hospital, LCECU, Shalom, and CDC) to the two main tertiary level hospitals, CMC Vellore main (Thottapalayam) and CMC Vellore Ranipet.
- Pre-hospital retrieval a facility available to the public of the Vellore and Ranipet districts. Any staff/student or the common public can call the 24x7 emergency helpline numbers for any emergency (trauma, chest pain, etc.,) from anywhere in Vellore City and Ranipet within a 15 km radius of the main hospitals. An ambulance would be dispatched to transfer the patient to the nearest emergency department (Town / Ranipet).



This enhancement underscores CMC Vellore's commitment to advancing healthcare in the region, ensuring that residents have access to timely and lifesaving medical interventions. The inauguration marks a significant milestone in the hospital's ongoing efforts to serve the community with excellence and compassion.





CMC Vellore celebrates World Plastic Surgery Day

The Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at CMC Vellore celebrated World Plastic Surgery Day on 15th of July. This year's theme was 'Plastic Surgery Changes Lives'.
