Tribute to a Lifetime of Service Dr. Annie Regi Retires



Dr. Annie Regi has made remarkable contributions to the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Christian Medical College Vellore, since she joined the institution in 1987. With a passion for medical education and a commitment to clinical excellence, Dr. Annie completed her MD in Obstetrics and Gynecology in 1990. Subsequently she joined OG Unit-III as a consultant where she worked with reputed colleagues including Dr. Balasubramaniam, Dr. Prabha Jairaj and Dr. Padmini Jasper. Together, they advanced both clinical standards and educational opportunities within the department.

One of her main areas of focus has been curriculum innovation for undergraduate medical students. She has been instrumental in shaping the next generation of healthcare providers, ensuring that they are better prepared to handle the challenges of medical practice. Recognising the importance of hands-on training in emergency obstetric care, she organised EmOC workshops which trained doctors from various regions of India. These workshops not only enhanced the knowledge and skills of participants but also positively impacted the quality of obstetric care across the country.

Dr. Annie's influence extended significantly after she assumed the role of Head of the Department in 2015. Under her leadership the department saw a substantial increase in the number of postgraduate seats, expanding it to three times of what it had been before. Her tenure was marked by a focus on research and collaboration, particularly through internationally funded studies. Her work with the late Professor Mark Steinhoff had profound impact on vaccination protocols for Influenza infection in pregnancy in India.

In addition to her administrative and academic achievements, Dr. Annie was committed to expanding clinical services at CMC Vellore. She initiated a perinatal clinic within Obstetrics and Gynecology Unit-III, providing specialised care for high-risk pregnancies. She also played a vital role in re-organising outpatient services for the OG department, enhancing patient flow and the overall experience for both patients and staff. Her efforts also extended to CMC Vellore Chittoor campus, where she supported the development of the OG department.

Dr. Annie's family also shares her commitment to healthcare. Her husband, Dr. Regi Oommen, is a renowned Radiation Oncologist who established the Nuclear Medicine Department in CMC Vellore. She is blessed with two daughters who have followed her footsteps into the medical profession. Her elder daughter, Dr. Soumya, is a consultant radiologist in the UK, married to Dr. Binu. Her younger daughter, Dr. Sneha, is working in the Department of Radiology. Dr. Annie takes great joy in spending time with her grandson, Nathaniel. Dr. Annie's career reflects 35 years of selfless service and dedication to her profession. She leaves behind a legacy of positive change in medical education, clinical services and research. Her impact will undoubtedly continue to be felt in the institution and among the countless individuals she has trained and mentored over the years.

The CMC community is thankful to Dr. Annie Regi and wishes her a joyful and fulfilling retirement.

16th International Short Course in Clinical Tropical Medicine

The Department of Infectious Diseases in collaboration with the departments of Wellcome Microbiology, Clinical Microbiology and Clinical Virology hosted the 16th International Short Course in Clinical Tropical Medicine from 18th to 30th November 2024 at IDTRC. Twenty-four students attended the two-week long course which offered lectures, clinical bedside sessions and laboratory practicals in bacteriology, virology, parasitology and mycology. Expertise was offered by international faculty from the McGill University Canada, Haukeland University, Albert Einstein College of Medicine New York, University of Oxford, NIMHANS Bangalore and School of Tropical Medicine, Kolkata. Faculty of CMC Vellore from the Departments of Wellcome Microbiology. Clinical Microbiology, Virology, Child Health III, Neurology, Medicine, Dermatology, SLRTC Karigiri, CHAD and Infectious Diseases contributed actively to the learning process. This course was started in 2007 and has received tremendous appreciation from the participants and so far, 131 Indians and 253 International students have been trained in the different aspects of Tropical Medicine. The feedback has been extremely positive and we hope to continue this programme in the following years with active participation from the CMC faculty.

Dr. Vijayanand and Dr. Ann Miriam, Missions Coordinators, provided insights into the various mission activities undertaken by CMC across its network hospitals. The programme concluded with a valedictory function, where participants were awarded certificates for their successful completion of the training. This initiative was made possible through support from the CMC Vellore Mission Network Grant 2023 and the Australian Alumni Grant 2023, provided by the Australian Consulate General, Chennai. The workshop was highly appreciated by participants, who expressed their gratitude for the opportunity to gain valuable skills and contribute more effectively to their laboratories and communities.
