Hospital Infection Prevention and Control Training Programme for the Healthcare Professionals of Timor-Leste



The Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC), Christian Medical College Vellore, India in collaboration with the World Health Organization (South East Asia Region) and the Ministry of Health, Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, had organised a five-day Hospital Infection Prevention and Control training programme for the healthcare professionals of Timor-Leste from 11th -15th November 2024.

This course was designed to sensitise the importance of Hospital Infection Prevention and Control among healthcare professionals working in Timor-Leste to enhance the quality of healthcare services and improve the health outcomes for the population. There were 5 participants representing -National Hospital (Dili, Timor-Leste), -Hospital Regional Educardo Ximenes (Baucau), -Referral Maubisse, -Hospital Referral Suai, -Hospital Referral Maliana.

The course commenced with the inaugural programme on 11th November 2024 in the Microbiology conference room. The event began with a prayer by Rev. Pearson Senior, Chaplain, Dr. Hema Paul Physician & Senior HICO welcomed the esteemed guests and the dignitaries for the day. Felicitations were offered by Dr. KPP Abhilash, Associate Medical Superintendent who congratulated the HICC team for organising the event in collaboration with the WHO and emphasised the importance of adherence to hand hygiene by all healthcare workers to combat hospital-acquired infections.

Dr. Rajiv Karthik Deputy Chairman HIC highlighted the training initiatives in place by HIC, such as a certificate course for nurses in Infection Prevention & Control (IPC) and Short course training in IPC & Antimicrobial stewardship (AMS) for doctors to provide an in-depth education on infection control principles and practices. Mrs. Alice Sony, nursing superintendent, expressed her gratitude to WHO and HIC for taking this initiative and wished the participants a good learning experience. Dr. John Antony Jude, secretary of HIC gave an overview of the course and mentioned that the certified, competency-based IPC course aimed to equip the participants with advanced skills and knowledge essential for implementing effective infection prevention and control measures within their healthcare settings.

Activities planned for the course included training sessions tailored to the unique needs of the hospitals in Timor-Leste. Expert medical, and nursing from various specialities and IPC specialists imparted interactive lectures and case-based discussions. Participants were taught the basic principles of Infection Control, Overview of Hospital-acquired Infections & Surveillance, Role of Environmental surveillance, Antimicrobial stewardship & Outbreak investigation & management. Visits were organized to observe the implementation of IPC practices in some high-risk areas like ICUs, OTs, dialysis, labour rooms etc. Skill stations were set up to practice Hand hygiene, Biomedical waste segregation PPE donning & doffing using case scenarios. Field visits were organized to Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility Ken-bio links at Kandipedu, laundry & CSSD.



The valedictory programme was held on 15th November 2024 at 3:30 pm in the Telemedicine conference Hall. Mrs. Jisha, the chaplain commenced the event with prayer followed by a welcome address delivered by Dr. Hema Paul . Felicitations were offered by Dr. Henry Prakash, Associate Medical Superintendent, Dr. Rajiv Karthik, & Mrs Shanthi Gladstone. Dr. Henry Prakash congratulated the participants on the successful completion of the course and distributed the certificates to the participants.

Dr. Rajiv Karthik, reminded us that Infection prevention and control along with Antibiotic stewardship been formed to prevent the development of resistance and reduce the spread of infections in our facility. Mrs. Shanthi Gladston mentioned that by implementing these measures, the institution can create a safe environment for patients, visitors, and healthcare workers, especially in the current scenario of emerging infections. The event ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Mr. Selvan Charge Nurse, HICC.

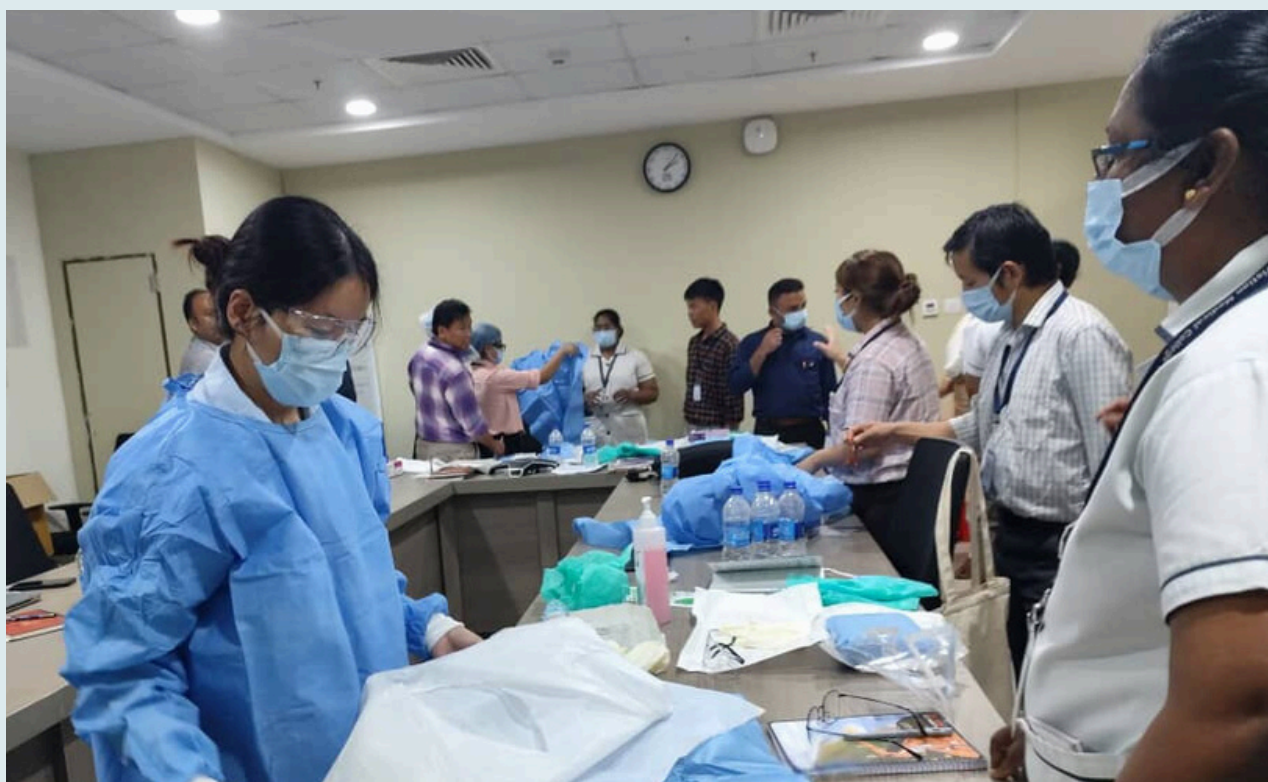

Infection Prevention & Control Training Programme for Healthcare Professionals from Bhutan



The Hospital Infection Prevention and Control Committee (HICC), Christian Medical College Vellore, in collaboration with the World Health Organization (WHO) South-East Asia Regional Office (SEARO) and National Medical Services (NMS), Royal Government of Bhutan, Thimphu, organised a certificate course in Infection Prevention & Control for nurses, Bhutan, from 18th November to 8th December 2024.

The hospital infection control committee in CMC Vellore has been recognised by the World Health Organization (WHO) South-East Asia Regional Office (SEARO) as a training centre for Infection prevention and control for nurses from Southeast Asian countries. This training programme was conducted as part of this initiative. 15 healthcare professionals comprising of one Pharmacist, one doctor twelve infection control focal points (nurses), and three lecturers from Kesar Gyalpo University of Medical Sciences Bhutan (KGUMSB) participated. The training aimed to emphasise the role of IPC in healthcare, and to equip the participants in all aspects of IPC, ultimately striving to improve healthcare quality and health outcomes for the population.



The programme commenced with an inaugural ceremony on 18th November 2024 at the NSO Board Room, Ranipet Campus. The event began with a prayer by Rev. Vijay Kumar, Chaplain, followed by a welcome address from Dr. John Jude, Professor and Head of Clinical Microbiology and Secretary of HICC. Dr. Hema Paul, Physician and Senior HICC Officer, provided an overview of the course and explained its importance. Felicitations were offered by Dr. Balamugesh T, Associate Medical Superintendent, Mrs. Jeyalinda Christopher, Associate Nursing Superintendent.

The three-week course comprised informative lectures and case discussions by expert faculties. Participants had the opportunity to learn to conduct audits, surveillance of healthcare-associated infections, and initiate outbreak investigations. They were able to visit to services like the ICU, OT, Clinical dietary, laundry, CSSD, post-mortem and mortuary to see the various IPC measures being practised. Skill stations and demonstration of hand hygiene, care of central and peripheral lines, donning and doffing of PPE and demonstration of some microbiological techniques in the Microbiology laboratory were also organised. As part of the field visit, participants had the opportunity to visit, the temporary storage area, sewage treatment plant on both campuses, and the CBMWTF located in Kandipedu, CHAD, and Chittoor campus. Faculty both Medical and Nursing, from multiple departments at CMC Vellore contributed actively to the learning process, providing expertise on a wide array of IPC topics within a healthcare setting.

The training programme concluded with a valedictory ceremony on 5th December 2024, held at Wheeler Hall. The event began with a prayer by Mrs. Jisha, Chaplain, followed by a welcome address from Dr. Rajiv Karthik. Dr. Hema Paul then presented a comprehensive report on the course. Felicitations were offered by Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director, who congratulated the participants and emphasised the importance of IPC practices in improving healthcare. Dr. Rajesh I, Medical Superintendent, also delivered a felicitation address, stressing the transformative effect of IPC implementation on the healthcare system. Mrs. Arockia Seeli Mabel, Deputy Nursing Superintendent, was also felicitated. The event concluded with a vote of thanks from Dr. Sarah G.

The participants provided positive feedback on the course. The initiative was seen as a significant step forward in strengthening infection prevention and control practices in healthcare facilities. We express our heartfelt thanks to the Lord Almighty for His guidance in making this initiative a success.

Cardiac Rehabilitation in CMC Vellore

Recovering from a heart attack is a challenging journey, but one that can be significantly eased with the help of cardiac rehabilitation. This medically supervised program combines exercise, education, and counselling to support heart health recovery, helping patients regain strength and reduce the risk of future heart problems.

Cardiac rehabilitation provides a structured and comprehensive approach to recovery, starting with a personalised exercise regimen designed to improve cardiovascular fitness gradually. Regular physical activity, supervised by trained professionals, can help rebuild stamina, lower blood pressure, and improve circulation, all essential for heart health. Over time, patients typically experience enhanced energy levels and a reduced risk of another heart attack.

Beyond physical exercise, cardiac rehabilitation focuses on educating patients about heart-healthy lifestyles. Participants learn about nutrition, stress management, smoking cessation, and the importance of taking prescribed medications. This holistic approach empowers individuals to make informed decisions that can contribute to long-term health improvements.

Psychological support is another key element of cardiac rehab. Recovering from a heart attack can be emotionally taxing, with anxiety and depression being common among patients. Counseling sessions and peer support groups can help address these challenges, promoting mental well-being and reducing the emotional strain of recovery.

Studies show that patients who complete a cardiac rehab program have a significantly lower risk of future heart-related events, such as another heart attack or heart failure. Cardiac rehabilitation has been linked to improved survival rates and a higher quality of life.

This program was restarted after the COVID pandemic in the Ranipet Campus of Christian Medical College Vellore in May 2023 by the combined efforts of the departments of Cardiology, Physiotherapy, and Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation. Over 60 patients who had experienced a heart attack were attended to in 2024, and 15 of those patients enrolled for the 6th edition of a marathon at Ranipet on 29th December 2024, organized by Jolly Boys Runners Club, Ranipet.

Mr. Raju (name changed) is a 43-year-old gentleman with very high cholesterol (LDL – 211 mg/dl), obesity (96 kgs), and stress. He had an acute myocardial infarction (heart attack) 15 months ago and was found to have two blocks in his coronary arteries. The blocks were opened by balloon angioplasty, and he was started on medication. In addition, he was initiated into the cardiac rehabilitation program at CMC Vellore, which comprises 36 out-patient sessions. He has lost weight, his cholesterol is now under control, and his effort tolerance has progressively increased. He was one of the runners who completed a full marathon of 42 km. Cardiac rehabilitation is thus a vital component of recovery after a heart attack. By addressing both the physical and emotional aspects of healing, it offers heart attack survivors the best chance for a healthy and active future.

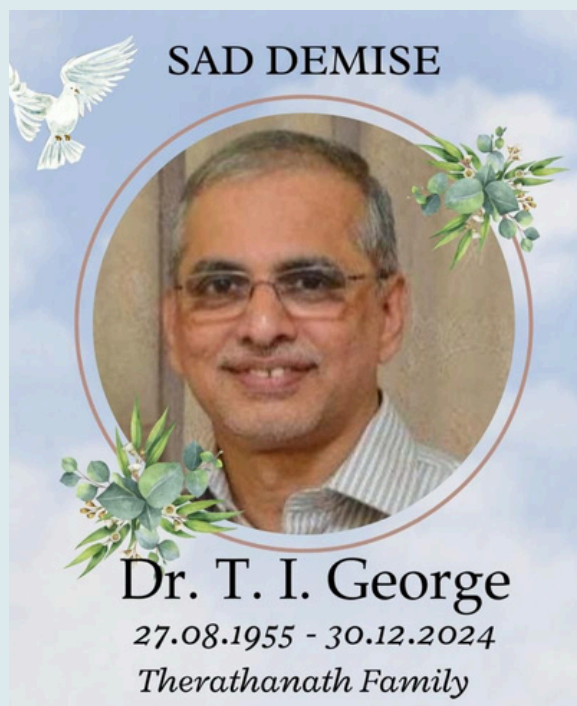



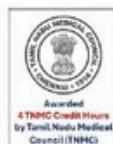
