### **World Leprosy Day**



World Leprosy Day was celebrated on December 30, 2025, with an awareness programme for the patients; organised by the Department of Dermatology, Venereology, and Leprosy, along with the Dermatology Nursing staff at the Town campus. The event featured stalls displaying splints, prostheses, and orthoses by the Hand and Leprosy Physiotherapy team. There was also a puppet show performed by the nursing staff from the Dermatology ward, as well as free patient screenings conducted by dermatologists, which were the highlights of the programme. The inauguration of the programme was honored by the presence of several distinguished guests, including Dr. David Mathew, Deputy Medical Superintendent; Dr. Binu P. Thomas, Senior Professor in the Department of Hand Surgery; Mrs. Annie Jerome, Associate Nursing Superintendent; Mrs. Sheebarani Nelson, Additional Deputy Dean of the College of Nursing; and Chaplains Rev. ### 16th Advance Course in Medical Education (ACME)

16th Advance Course in Medical Education (ACME) contact course, approved by the National Medical Commission, took place from 3rd – 10th February 2025. The course was organised for faculties working in 61 affiliated Medical Colleges. All 58 faculties -31 Professors, 23 Associate Professors, and 4 Assistant Professors actively participated and gained immense knowledge from the faculties of the Medical Education Department, NMC Nodal Centre, CMC, Vellore.

This course is designed to help faculty develop advanced knowledge and skills in the principles and application of medical education. Participants were introduced to various topics, including:

- Designing Curriculum with the 6 steps of Kern's Cycle
- Teaching Learning Strategies
- Project Planning
- Educational Research
- Assessment learning
- Skills training
- Educational Scholarship
- Quality Assurance
- Change Management
- Leadership, Managing Change
- Abstract Writing
- Mentoring and Project beyond 6 months.

These interactive sessions involved participants in small group activities to enhance engagement and learning.

On February 7, 2025, the poster presentations for the Contact Course II participants were organised. Seniors showcased their posters in small groups, while juniors presented the seniors' projects in larger groups. The posters and their presentations were evaluated by esteemed judges, who ranked them based on specific criteria. Dr. Priyanka Pappala, Professor in the Department of Pathology at Great Eastern Medical School & Hospital in Ragolu, Srikakulam District, won first prize for her poster titled *Gamification in Medical Training: A Study on Engagement and Knowledge Retention in Undergraduate Medical Education.* The second prize was awarded jointly to Dr. Srujan Lam Sharma, Associate Professor in the Department of Trauma Surgery at CMC Vellore, for his poster titled *On-site Trauma Team Simulation as an Educational Tool Towards Improving Trauma Resuscitation – A Pilot Study* and Dr. P. Jagadeesh, Professor and Head of the Department of Pharmacology at NRI Institute of Medical Sciences in Sangivalasa, Visakhapatnam, for his poster titled *Implementation and Evaluation of the Jigsaw Method of Cooperative Learning in Teaching Pharmacology to Undergraduate Medical Students.* The winners received bestselling medical education books as awards.

### **Obituaries**



**Dr. Hem Chandra Kumar Laljee** (MBBS batch of 1953), passed away on 18th January, 2025. Dr. Hem Chandra Kumar Laljee was born in Mungeli, Bilaspur, Madhya Pradesh on 10.10.1932. He completed his B.Sc., from the Ewing Christian College, Allahabad and joined for his MBBS in CMC Vellore during the year 1953 and graduated in 1959. He took MRCP in Endocrinology from Edinburgh in 1964 and spent all his working life for the NHS. He went into medical research in England, taking Ph.D. in Neurophysiology from the University of Sheffield in 1967.

He then held the Boots Research Fellowship at Sheffield for two years. In view of his combination expertise in both fundamental and clinical sciences, he was appointed Consultant in Clinical Neurophysiology for the Health Region around Portsmouth and Salisbury. With his exceptional skills in electrophysiology, he has helped to provide services such as EEG, EMG and Evoked potentials in this region. His special interest was the study of epilepsies. He married his wife Mrs. Mary Edmondson in 1964, a nurse who was Clinical Nurse Manager for Elderly Service. Their children Mr. David John works in IT and Dr. Ruth Guest is a General Practitioner. He always spoke with great fondness of his time at Vellore and he has now returned to his Father in heaven.

**Dr. Shankar Krishnaswamy** - former Head of the department of cardiology passed away on 6th February, 2025. He was born on February 26, 1938. At a young age, his family migrated from Burma to India and settled near Coimbatore, where he completed his schooling at Stanes school before joining Christian Medical College (CMC) in 1958. From the very beginning, he distinguished himself as one of the brightest students in his batch, deeply committed to his studies while also nurturing a profound love for music. A talented musician, he actively participated in college music programs alongside fellow musicians Donald Roberts and Vijayasenan. As the guitarist for the band The Cracker Jacks, he played at numerous college events, leaving behind fond memories for many.



After earning his MD in Medicine from CMC Vellore, Dr. Shankar joined the fifth batch (1969) of the DM Cardiology training program at CMC and later became the fourth Head of the Department. A pioneer in the field of cardiology, he played a crucial role in revolutionizing coronary angiography in India. Between 1974 and 1976, Dr. Shankar trained under Dr. Goffredo Gensini, Director of Cardiology at St. Joseph's Hospital, New York. His contributions were recognized in Dr. Gensini's authoritative manual on coronary angiography. Upon returning to India, Dr. Shankar introduced the Sones technique for coronary angiography at CMC Vellore, a groundbreaking step at the time. The procedure, performed using the brachial approach, was a crucial requirement for the CABG programme, starting at a few centers in India around that time. In the early days, angiograms were recorded on cine films, which were painstakingly developed in a darkroom by Mr. C. Babu and Mr. John Krishnamurthy. The process was laborious, and with no playback option available in the cath lab, the only person who could reliably interpret the angiograms was the one who performed them—often Dr. Shankar himself.

Dr. Shankar meticulously documented every coronary angiogram performed at CMC Vellore, creating a detailed database far ahead of its time. His foresight led to the digital storage of this data, a remarkable achievement in an era when computers were not widely used in clinical practice. The first computer for the Cardiology Department was purchased using his earnings from a two-week WHO assignment in Nepal. True to his curiosity and love for technology, he dismantled and reassembled the computer within two months of its arrival. His extensive clinical and angiographic database of over 4,000 patients, created almost single-handedly in SPSS format (version 4), provided invaluable insights into coronary artery disease in Indian patients. Dr. Richard from the Biostatistics Department assisted him in data analysis, leading to multiple publications that shaped the understanding of heart disease in India. With over 130 publications and numerous citations in international journals, Dr. Shankar collaborated with ICMR and WHO on epidemiological studies related to coronary and rheumatic heart diseases in and around Vellore.

Dr. Shankar's most significant contribution to CMC was his dedication to sustaining the Cardiology Department and the DM Cardiology course after the untimely passing of Dr. I.P. Sukumar in 1985. For a period in 1986, he was the only consultant in the department, single-handedly managing patient care, teaching, catheterization procedures, and administrative responsibilities with the help of postgraduate students. He played a key role in advancing interventional cardiology at CMC, initiating coronary angioplasty in 1988 with Dr. P.C. Rath and balloon mitral valvotomy in 1990 with Dr. Niraj Prasad. An entire generation of cardiologists owes their training in coronary angiography to him.

Dr. Shankar's interests extended far beyond medicine. An avid electronics enthusiast, he personally built electronic clocks for three areas of the Cardiology Department, which functioned for years. When a computer from the Nuclear Medicine Department was condemned, he salvaged it and spent countless evenings tinkering with it, much like a child with a Meccano set. His love for music remained undiminished throughout his life. A gifted singer and guitarist, he surprised colleagues at a departmental Christmas dinner in 1989 by picking up a guitar and singing Next Stop is Vietnam. In retirement, he took up learning the piano, demonstrating the same dedication and enthusiasm that marked his professional life.

In recognition of his immense contributions to cardiology and medical education, the cardiology department had honored Dr. Shankar Krishnaswami with the Mentor to Generations of Students award in 2024.

Dr. Shankar was married to Dr. Hemalatha Airan, a distinguished pathologist and fellow CMC graduate (Batch of 1958). He is survived by his son, Dr. Rajiv Karthik who continues their legacy as a professor of infectious diseases at CMC, daughter in law Sheby Rajiv, welfare officer in the directorate and grandchildren Rohan and Leah. Dr. Shankar's expertise extended beyond his medical and academic achievements. He was a mentor, a musician, a technologist, and above all, a cherished friend. His warmth, intelligence, and unwavering dedication to his family, students, and community set him apart as a truly remarkable individual. Though he is no longer with us, his legacy endures through the lives he touched and the knowledge he imparted. #### • SPONSORSHIP FOR STAFF CHILDREN – ADMISSIONS 2025 – 2026

Applications are invited from staff for sponsorship of their children for admission to the various training courses in the Christian Medical College, Vellore for the Academic Year 2024 - 2025. Online sponsorship forms will be available in the Intranet page à Staff Self Service à Sponsorship Portal from 12th February 2025 onwards. Retired Staff can kindly contact Directorate for applying online sponsorship form.

**A. Eligibility:** (Cl.Min.No.5188-11-79; 7449:6:93 & 9282:1-2003)

- 1. Only children of confirmed C.M.C staff members who:
- (a) have put in 10 years of continuous service including period of probation and are currently in service in any capacity in the Institution as on 30th June of the year under consideration; (OR)
- (b) have retired after at least 15 years of continuous service in the Institution, or have taken voluntary retirement after 25 y ears of continuous service; (OR)
- (c)have been discharged from service on medical grounds after at least 15 years of continuous service; (OR)
- (d) have died during service after at least 10 years of continuous service in this Institution are eligible to apply for sponsorship.
- 2. Legally adopted children of staff members whose adoption was finalized at least five years before the date of application are also eligible for sponsorship, subject to the above criteria.
- 3. Regarding a confirmed staff member who died during service tothe institution and whose spouse has been given a job in CMC in place of the deceased staff member, dependent children of the deceased staff member will be eligible for CMC sponsorship if the cumulative years of service of the deceased staff member and his/her spouse (including probation and confirmed periods) exceeds 10 years; in case the child applying for sponsorship was legally adopted by the deceased staff member, the adoption of the child should have been finalized:
- (a) prior to the death of the deceased staff member, and
- (b) at least five years before the date of application for sponsorship

### B. Conditions for sponsorship of staff children (Cl. Min.5759:3-84)

- (a) Only one child from a family can be admitted in a year to any single course.
- (b) Children from the same family can, however, be admitted to different course in the same year.
- (c) Sponsorship is allowed from only one sponsoring body, so children applying for C.M.C. sponsorship cannot also be sponsored by one of the supporting Churches of the Council.
- (d)Where there is more than one sponsorship obtained, the one received first which satisfies the criteria will be accepted.
- (e) No withdrawal of first received valid sponsorship is allowed.

Staff children, even with CMC sponsorship, must still meet the minimum academic qualifications for the courses for which they are applying. Staff are urged to check the prospectus to ensure the eligibility of their children for the various courses before submitting their applications.
